## No More Condemnation Romans 8:1-4 August 11th, 2024 Mike Butler

## Romans 8:1-4 (NKJV)

"1. There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. 2. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. 3. For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, 4. that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit."

- Romans 8:18 "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.."
- Romans 8:31 "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?"
- Romans 8:31 "Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us....".
- Romans 8: 38-39 "For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, neither angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

## Eight Key Points of Chapters 1-7

- Number 1 There is One God
- Number 2 The One God is all holy,
- Number 3 But we are not holy Because we all sin And therefore we cannot live in God's heaven Which is holy
- Number 4 Our unholiness makes us subject to God's wrath because our sins must be punished
- Number 5 So God gave mankind His "law" His commandments For us to live by –
  And to show us our sin
- Number 6 Then God made a plan to pay our debt Forgive our sin and escape punishment Through faith in His promise
- **Number 7** But there's a catch Grace can only be applied only one way Through the work of Christ on the cross,
- **Number 8** But when we're saved Jesus Who is Holy Pays the debt for those who are unholy And therefore, we can now say...
  - "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus..."."
- Galatians 3:21-22 "For if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly righteousness [salvation] would have been by the law. But the Scripture has

- confined <u>all under sin</u>, that the promise <u>by faith</u> in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe."
- Psalm 1:6, "For the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the ungodly shall perish."
- Psalm 1:1 "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners".
- Matthew 28:19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 "Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?".
- 2 Corinthians 3:17 "Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.".
- Acts 13:39 "And by Him [Jesus] everyone who believes is justified [saved] from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses"
- Matthew 5:17 "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill."
- Galatians 4:4-5 "But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons."
- Hebrews 4:15 "For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, <u>yet without sin."</u>
- Romans 6:6 "Knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin."
- 1 John 5:10-11 "He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; he who does not believe in God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son."
- Ephesians 2:10 "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."
- Psalm 90:12 "So teach <u>us</u> to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom."
- Psalm 139:1-3 "O Lord, You have searched me and known me. You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off. You comprehend my path and my lying down, and are acquainted with all my ways.".
- John 3:18 "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."
