1. Introduction:

- a. Taking a look back:
 - 1) "It is finished." Jesus had fully satisfied God's holy righteous wrath against all sin.
 - a) Jesus wiped away our debt of sin.
 - 2) The veil stood as a remind that man is separated from God because of sin.
 - a) God ripped the veil from top to bottom.
 - 3) The Centurion "Truly this man was the Son of God."
- b. Taking a look ahead:
 - 1) So, what happened next?
 - a) For some, it was over!
 - 2) Did Jesus really die?
 - a) Romans were good at execution by torture and crucifixion.
 - 3) Even with the evidence some still wonder, did Jesus really die? Was He buried? Did He rise from the grave?
- 2. Jesus Christ, the God Man. Sometimes the question is this...
 - a. How can God die?
 - 1) What happened to the Father and the Holy Spirit if the Son was dead?
 - a) Jesus was fully God and fully man.
 - b. Jesus was fully man:
 - 1) Jesus had a normal physical birth Luke 2:7
 - 2) Jesus was seen as a human child. Luke 2:17
 - 3) Jesus referred to Himself as the Son of Man. Matthew 18:11
 - c. Jesus was fully God.
 - 1) At the same time, dwelling in the same body was God the Word. John 1:14. Phil. 2:6-8
 - d. What happened to Jesus?
 - 1) What happened to the part of Jesus that was fully God when the part that was fully man died?
 - 2) Jesus went to Abraham's bosom which was the location where the righteous would go instead of hell until the death of Christ opened the way to heaven.
 - a) Matthew 27:51-53 -
 - b) The graves were opened and those who slept, those who died believing in Jesus, arose with Him at the resurrection.
 - 3) Next, Jesus ascended to Heaven and brought the righteous spirits with Him. I Peter 3:18-19
- 3. Who raised Jesus from the dead?
 - a. Jesus did die!
 - 1) God is One Being, composed of three separate and distinct but equal Persons The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
 - 2) Did God the Father raise Jesus? Yes!
 - a) Acts 2:32 -
 - b) Romans 6:4 –
 - 3) Since Jesus is the second part of the Godhead, Jesus raised Himself back from the dead.
 - a) John 2:18-19 -
 - b) John 10:18 -
 - 4) The Holy Spirit was also involved in the resurrection of Jesus.

- 4. Is there any believable evidence for the Resurrection?
 - a. Eyewitness testimony.
 - 1) Several hundred people saw the resurrected Christ. I Cor. 15:5-6
 - b. How can we be sure of their testimony?
 - 1) Did you know many of these eyewitnesses endured terrible things because of their faith?
 - 2) They could have ended their suffering if they had simply renounced their faith.
 - 3) Martyrdom is remarkable but is it compelling?
 - a) Being a martyr does not validate a belief, but it authenticates the believer.
 - b) The early Christian martyrs were the first generation.
 - 4) What about the Apostles?
 - a) They were undeniably changed by the fact that they saw the resurrected Christ.
 - 5) Application Knowing that death is not the end brought courage.
 - c. A persecutor turned preacher.
 - 1) Paul and his life before and after Christ must be a part of the evidence.
 - 2) Application Do you believe this based on the evidence we can read about this person whose life had been changed?
 - a) Just as their life has born witness to you that Jesus is real and that life change does carry with it a testimony, let that remind you of how important your testimony can be to someone who is watching, reading your life.
