## THE POWER OF PRAISE

### 7 Biblical Words for Praise

**HALAL** — to rave, boast, celebrate, to be clamorously foolish

**PSALM 35:18** — *I will thank you in front of the great assembly.  
I will praise you before all the people.*

**YADAH** — to acknowledge in public

**PSALM 138:1** — *I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart.*

**BARAK** — to bless by kneeling or bowing

**PSALM 103:1** — *Praise the LORD, O my soul; all my inmost being,  
praise his holy name.*

**ZAMAR** — making music to God with strings

**PSALM 92:1** — *It is good to praise the LORD and make music to your  
name, O Most High.*

**SHABACH** — to address in a loud tone, to shout

**PSALM 63:3-4** — *Because your love is better than life, my lips will  
glorify you. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I  
will lift up my hands.*

**TOWDAH** — to lift hands in adoration

**PSALM 50:23** — *He who offers praise glorifies me: and to him that  
orders his conversation aright will I show the salvation of God.*

**TEHILLAH** — exuberant singing

**PSALM 34:1** — *I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will  
always be on my lips.*
