

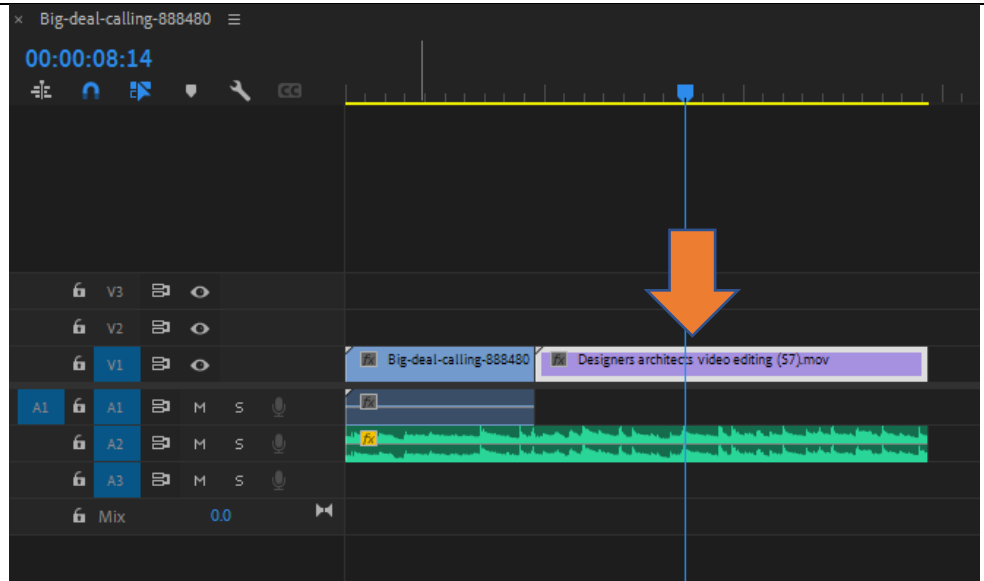


Adjusting Lighting/Coloring in Premiere Pro

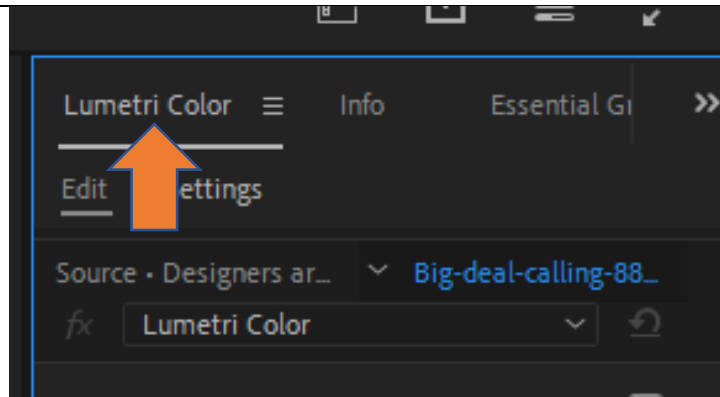

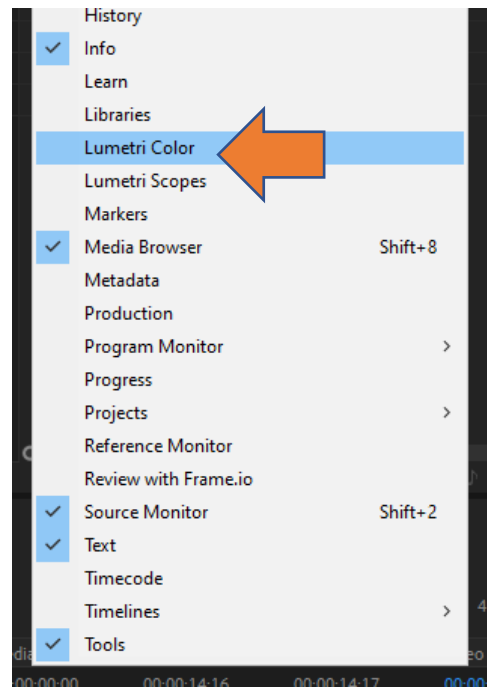
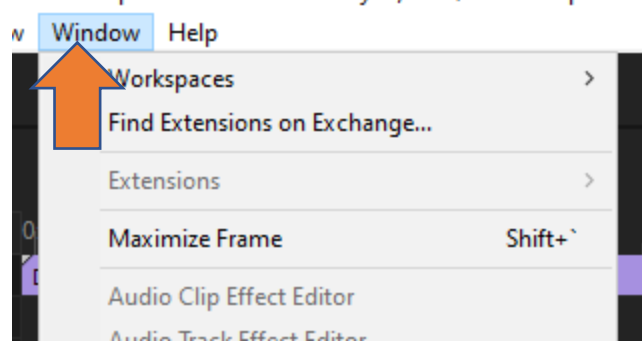
Once your video is opened in your timeline, select the video so that it is highlighted.



Select the Lumetri Color panel.

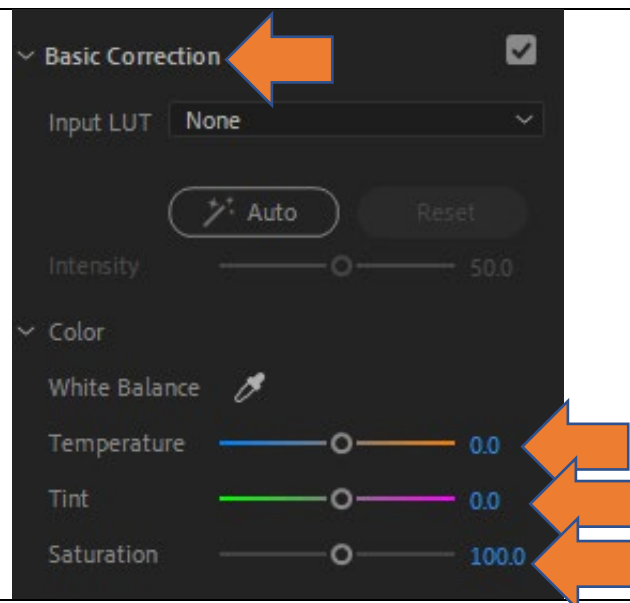


OPTIONAL: If you do not already see the Lumetri Color panel in your project, go under the Window tab and select 'Lumetri Color'.



Under the Basic Correction section, you can adjust the temperature, tint, and saturation of the video.

Temperature adjusts if your footage looks warmer or cooler.



Tint adjusts the greens and purples in your footage (ie. if there is stronger purple in your footage, dragging it left towards the green can balance the coloring.

Saturation adjusts all coloring on a video, higher saturation increases the coloring, lower saturation decreases it.

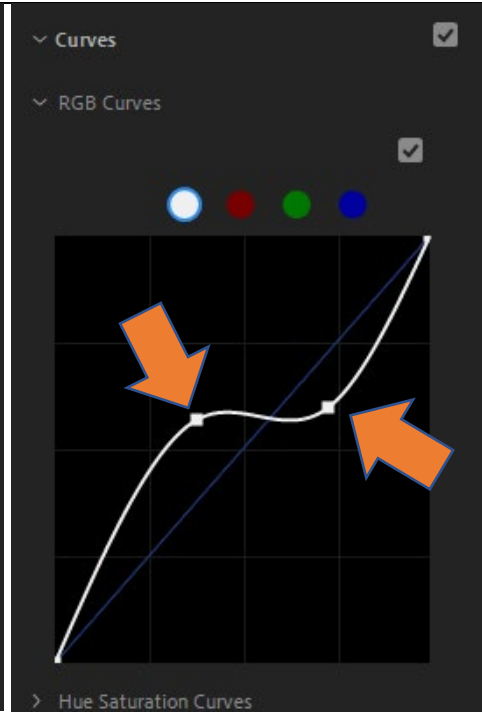
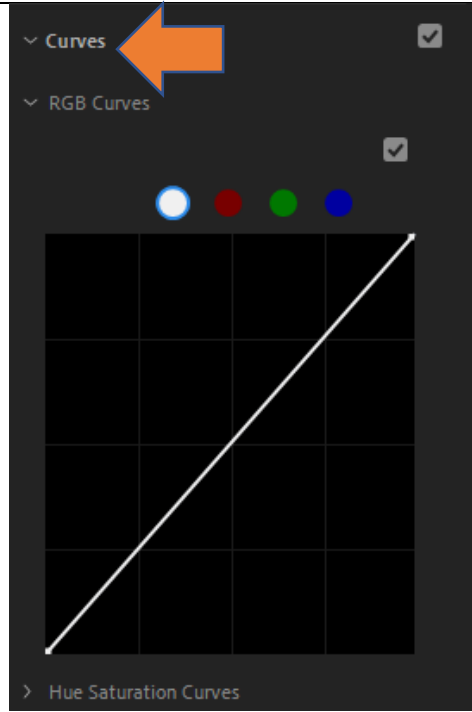
To adjust the brightness of the video, grab and move the circle next to 'Exposure'.

Moving to the right increases the brightness while moving to the left decreases the brightness.



<p>To further adjust the lighting, move the circle next to 'Contrast' to the left or right.</p> <p>Moving to the left will result the video being brighter while moving to the right will make it darker.</p>		
<p>To continue to adjust the color of the video, move the Highlights, Shadows, Whites, and Black circles as you did in the previous steps.</p>
