Prayer

We all wrestle with self-doubts. So share a time when you had doubts concerning your ability to accomplish something, but with the encouragement of another person (or persons), you actually succeeded at something you thought you couldn't do.

Digging Deep

- 1. Thinking back to Sunday's message, was there any idea or insight that surprised you, challenged you or helped you better understand God's will for your life? Please share.
- 2. Read Luke 2:52. The New Testament is clear in its presentation of Jesus as BOTH human (man) and divine (God). Because our Lord was truly human, He is therefore our supreme example of how to live our lives in utter reliance on a partnership with the Holy Spirit. Take a moment to share details about Jesus' life which underline His humanity (connection with us).
- 3. Reviewing your sermon notes list some of the ways that Jesus clearly manifested on on-going partnership with the Holy Spirit.

Digging Deeper

- 4. **Read Hebrews 4:15.** How can we consider Jesus the great sympathizer? How does the Holy Spirit help us when we are tempted?
- 5. Read Luke 4:1-13. What tactics did Jesus use (in partnership with the Holy Spirit) to resist temptation in this passage? How can we model our own trials after the trial Jesus was put through?

6. Read Romans 8:5-9,13 and Galatians 5:19-21. As fallen sinners, our default reactions/responses to challenges often display what the New Testament calls "flesh" or "sinful nature." How does the Holy Spirit help believers who are seeking to live under His leadership (and not the flesh)?

DIGGING EVEN DEEPER

- 7. Read Galatians 5:22-25. What are the potential outcomes of "keeping in step" with the Holy Spirit? What do you think would be the most immediate changes in your life if you leaned into a closer partnership with the Holy Spirit?
- 8. Read 2 Corinthians 1:21-22. This passage clearly says that believers are anointed by God to accomplish His purpose/mission on earth. What does this "anointing" actually mean in practical terms?

9) Thinking back on the skits during Sunday's message, how do you think a believer's reliance on the Holy Spirit's wisdom, guidance and empowerment can turn a normal conversation into a spiritual one? Think about the current relationships in your life and ask God to give you an opportunity to practice leading a conversation in a spiritual direction. List a few names of people who could truly benefit from this.
