UNDERSTANDING PROGRESSIVE REVELATION

- God has revealed Himself progressively... not all at once, but rather over time
- He has continually dropped clues for us along the way in (revealed) Scripture
- As revealed light increases, so does clarity of understanding
- Progressive revelation builds on previously revealed truth (& does not contradict it)
- With each additional clue, the overall picture of God's character, operations & intentions becomes clearer and clearer
- God is eternal & therefore exists outside of time-space history... even the future is already past for God
- Jesus Christ has always been the center of God's story
- So all human history must either point forward or backward to the person & work of Jesus Christ
