

Good News! We actually have more New Testament instruction on the proper and improper use of the gift of tongues than any other spiritual gift (in 1 Corinthians 14)

- \rightarrow Tongues are generally misunderstood by others (Mysteries of the Spirit) (v.2)
- → "Anyone who speaks in a tongue edifies themselves" (v.4)
- → Other gifts (like prophecy) are more helpful to the church (v.5)
- → "Try to excel in those (gifts) that build up the church." (v.12; also see vv.26,33,40)
- → It is more beneficial to engage both your spirit & mind (vv.13-17)
- \rightarrow 5 intelligible words of prophecy = 10,000 unintelligible words in tongues (v.19)
- → Tongues are best used evangelistically (v.22)... it's a gift designed as a sign for unbelievers
- \rightarrow People who don't understand this gift will think you're crazy if you exercise it (v.23)
- → Tongues should never be exercised in church without interpretation (vv.27-28)




