Prayer

Take a few moments to catch up with each other. Make sure everyone has a chance to share. Then open your time together in prayer and invite the Lord to be your guide.

Answer one of the following questions:

- ► What's the first thing to comes to mind when you think about the concept of worshiping God?
- ► Share one of the most profound, meaningful experiences you have ever had in your relationship with God.

Digging Deep

- 1. Read Isaiah 6:1-8. Imagine you are Isaiah. What do you tell a friend about what you saw, heard, felt and smelled in verses 1-4? How do you think this experience of "seeing God" etched itself on Isaiah's life and ministry?
- 2. Read John 4:23-24. Jesus speaks of God seeking human beings who will worship Him. What kind of worshipers is God seeking? Why is worship a spirit to Spirit experience (human to God's Spirit), rather than a question of being in the right place geographically? Discuss what it means to worship God in truth.
- 3. On Sunday, Pastor Peter said that everybody worships something. How is this statement true?
- 4. Read Revelation 4:1-11. This is perhaps the greatest worship experience mentioned in the Bible. Take some time to list what is going on in these verses.



Digging Deeper

5. Read Revelation 5:1-14. The focus of the worship in this chapter is on the Lamb, or Son of God (Jesus). List some of the ways in which the Lamb is worshiped or honored in this chapter. Why is this scene important for the Christ-follower today?



Taking it Home

- 6. Pastor Peter offered a number of practical ways that we can build worship into our lives from Monday to Saturday. (You can cheat and revisit the sermon outline!) Share one way you intend to incorporate the worship of God this week in your life.
- 7. Read Colossians 3:16. Now read it again! What is the Apostle Paul exhorting everyone of us to do on a regular basis here? How do these holy habits benefit us as worshipers?
- 8. Zephaniah 3:17 says, 'The LORD your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in His love He will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing.' Have you ever had a person 'sing over you?' How did it make you feel? How would you feel if God sang a song of delight over you?

Praying Together

Share with each other any prayer needs you have. Then pray for each other. Ask God specifically to help each of you become the kind of worshiper the Father is seeking.

THOUGHT: There is no true discipleship without worship. Your Pathway of Discipleship should be lived in an atmosphere of worship.
