- ➤ Warning: Established Belief takes time, obedience & training in righteousness. Many believers never learn the beauty, freedom, fruitfulness & power that comes from Established Belief.
- ➤ This phase of spiritual development is marked with growing discernment & regular divine appointments
- ➤ Example of Philip: Acts 8:4-25 Revival in Samaria / Acts 8:26-40 Salvation of Ethiopian Eunuch
- ➤ Established Belief Christians are "Dangerous Christians"
- ➤ Holy Spirit's Primary Tools during this phase of our journey
 - Prayer Scripture Obedience Community
 - Embedded Habits Momentum Maturity
- ➤ Galatians 5:25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
