a) Jesus Informed the Disciples of His Suffering and Rejection (8:31)

(1) The General Outcome of His Ministry (8:31a-b₉)

(a) The Necessity of His Suffering (8:31a-b₆)

- must compulsion of any kind

(b) The Nature of His Suffering (8:31a-b₇₋₉)

- suffer to experience something from outside

(2) The Specific Details of That Outcome (8:31b₉₋₃₁)

- rejected result of testing, verifying, or examining

b) Jesus Rebuked by Peter out of Concern (8:32)

- plainly freedom of speech

c) Jesus Rebuked Peter out of Necessity (8:33)

- setting mind on to think; to focus on; to feel
