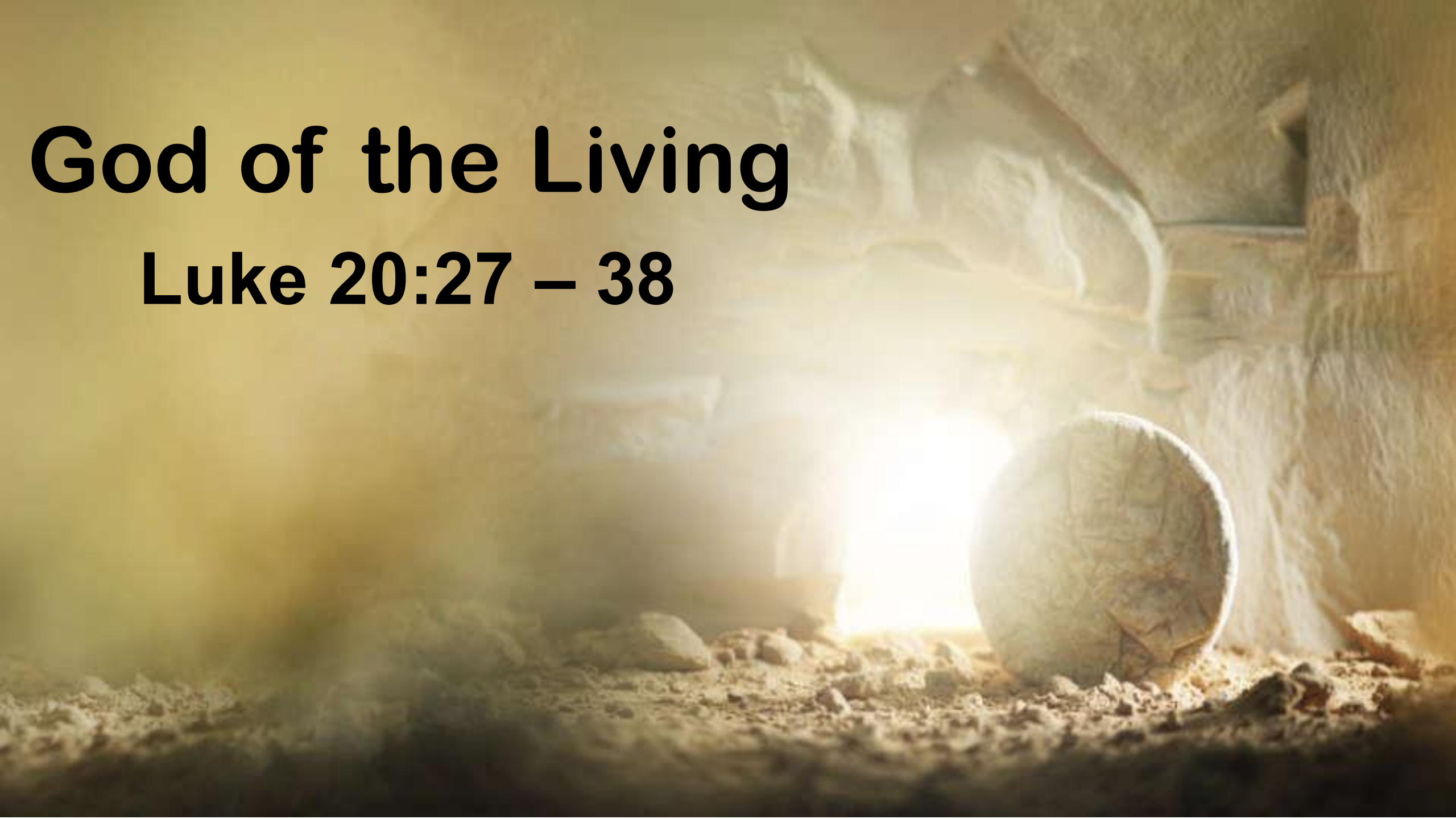


God of the Living

Luke 20:27 – 38



Acts 23:6-8

“But perceiving that one group were Sadducees and the other Pharisees, Paul began crying out in the Council, “Brethren, I am a Pharisee, a son of Pharisees; I am on trial for the hope and resurrection of the dead!” 7 As he said this, there occurred a dissension between the Pharisees and Sadducees, and the assembly was divided. 8 For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor an angel, nor a spirit, but the Pharisees acknowledge them all.”

Sadducees

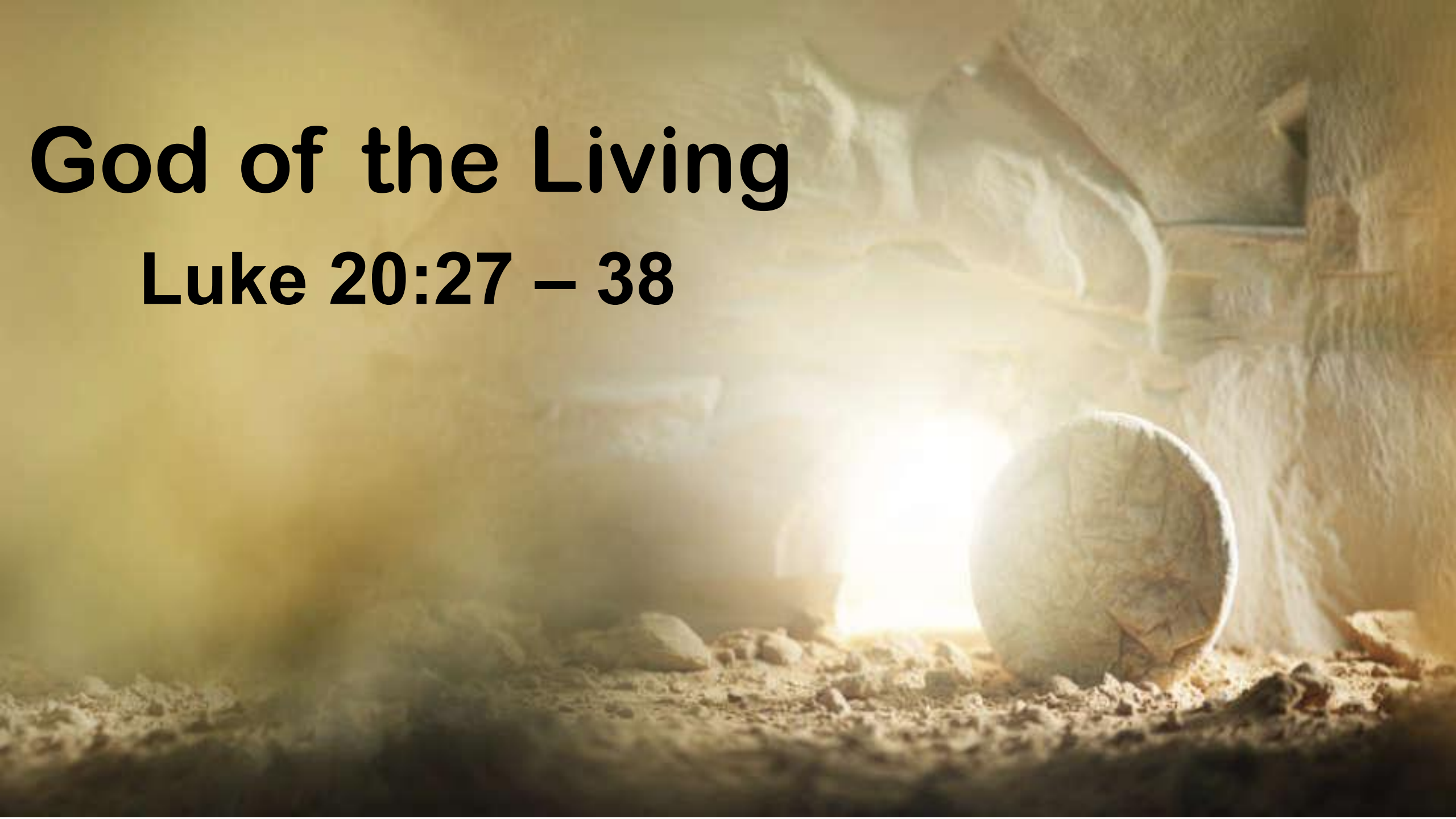
1. *Small but powerful religious/political group*
2. *Not interested in purity or Sabbath laws*
3. *Scripture limited to Moses' writings*
4. *God had limited influence.*
5. *No angels*
6. *Humans weren't spiritual beings*
7. *Emphasis on this life; there was no future life.*
8. *No resurrection*

Levirate Marriage – Deut. 25:5-10

“When brothers live together and one of them dies and has no son, the wife of the deceased shall not be married outside the family to a strange man. Her husband’s brother shall go in to her and take her to himself as wife and perform the duty of a husband’s brother to her. 6 “It shall be that the firstborn whom she bears shall assume the name of his dead brother, so that his name will not be blotted out from Israel...”

1 Corinthians 15:50

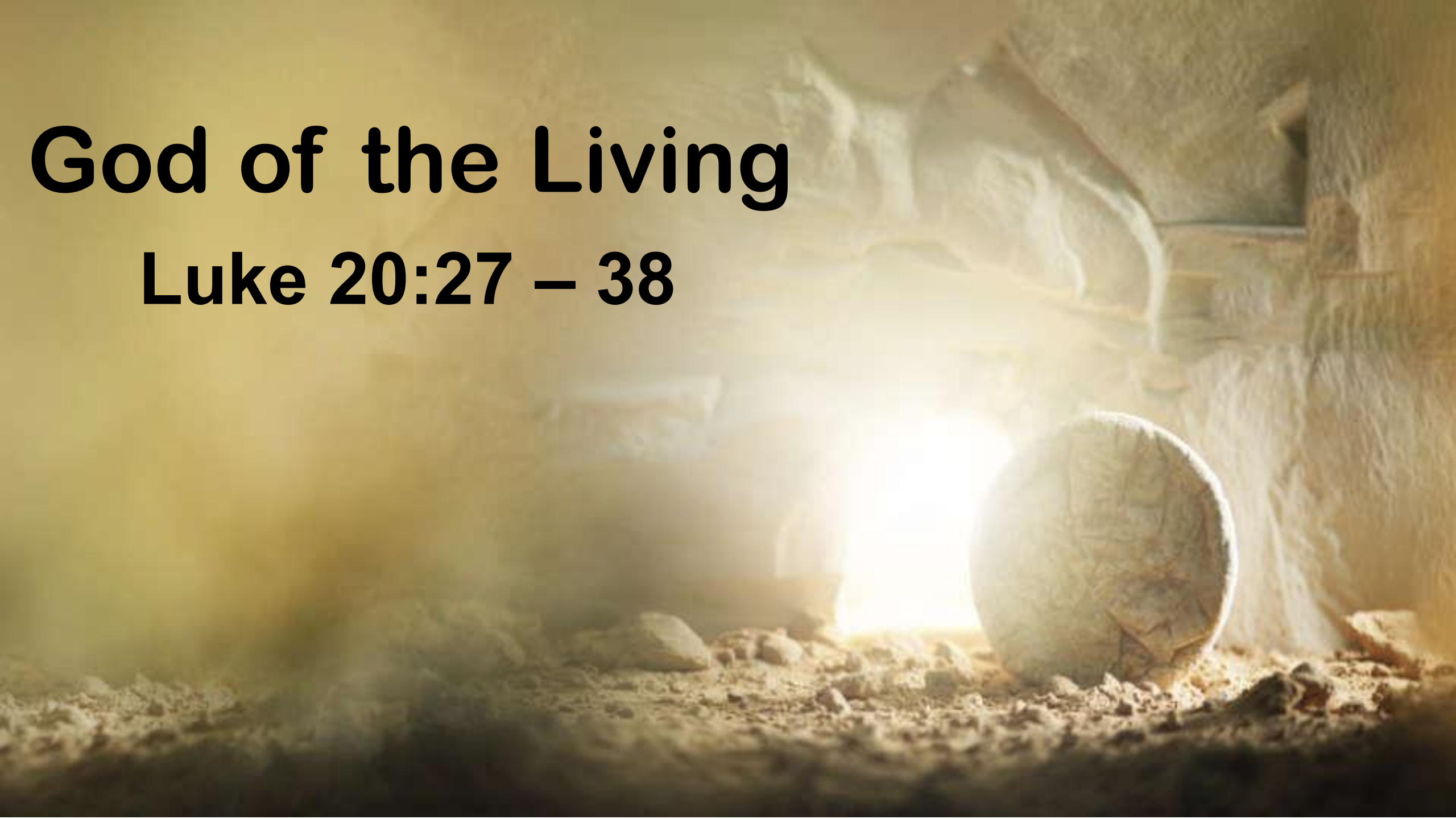
“Now I say this, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.”
