Exodus 24:12-18

Exodus 31:18

“When He had finished speaking with him upon Mount Sinai, He gave Moses the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone, written by the finger of God.”

- *Exodus 34:28 “..And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.”*
- *Exodus 32:15 "written on both sides".*

Physically there were two written back and front with the 10 Commandments, which Moses carried.

“Consuming fire”

- *Deut. 4:24 “For the LORD your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God.”*
- *Deuteronomy 9:3 “Know therefore today that it is the LORD your God who is crossing over before you as a consuming fire. He will destroy them...”*
- *Hebrews 12:29 “...we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe; 29 for our God is a consuming fire.”*

“Transcendent”

Jeremiah 9:24 “... let him who boasts boast of this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the Lord who exercises lovingkindness, justice and righteousness on earth; for I delight in these things,” declares the Lord.

Jeremiah 24:7 “I will give them a heart to know Me, for I am the Lord; and they will be My people, and I will be their God, for they will return to Me with their whole heart.”

“Transcendent”

Acts 17:27–28 *“that they would seek God, if perhaps they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us; 28 for in Him we live and move and exist...”*

Jeremiah 23:23 *“Am I a God who is near,” declares the Lord, “And not a God far off?”*

God is “with us”

Psalm 139:5–7 “You have enclosed me behind and before, And laid Your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is too high, I cannot attain to it. 7 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence?”

Psalm 16:11 “You will make known to me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever.”
