Similarities between Sacrifices

- 1. Each should occur at the door of the Tent of Meeting.**
- 2. The priests were to lay hands upon the animal, identifying with it.**
- 3. The animal should be killed**
- 4. A blood ritual would occur.**
- 5. The animal would be sacrificed.**
