

13 Methods of Revelation

1. Speech – (Gen. 1:3, 24; 2:16-17; 3:16-19; Exo. 20:1-3; Psa. 33:6; Heb. 1:3)
2. Personal Writing - (Gen. 34)
3. Talking Animal – (Num. 22:22-41)
4. The Lot - (Prov. 16:33; Acts 1:21-26)
5. The Urim and Thummim - (Exo. 28:30; Num. 27:21; Deut. 33:8; 1st Sam. 28:6; Ezra 2:63)

13 Methods of Revelation

6. An Ephod - (Exo. 28; 1st Sam. 23:6, 9; Hos. 3:4)
7. Dreams - (Gen. 20:3, 6; 31:11-13, 24, 40-41; Joel 2:28). Also to unbelievers (Gen. 20:3; 31:24)
8. Visions - (Isa. 1:1; 6:1; Eze. 1:3)
9. Theophanies – (Gen. 16:7-14; Exo. 3:2; 2nd Sam. 24:16; Zech. 1:12)

13 Methods of Revelation

10. Angels – (Dan. 9:20-21; Luke 2:10-11; Rev. 1:1)
11. Jesus Christ – (Joh. 1:14; 3:2; 7:46; 14:9; 1st Joh. 1:1-3; Rom. 5:8 John 2:1; Mat. 16:17)
12. “History” – (Mic. 6:5; Ezek. 25:7; Joh. 1:14) With caveats...
13. Prophets – Most popular (2nd Sam. 23:2; Zech. 1:1; Jer. 1:7, 9; Eph. 5:3)

Numbers 27:18–21

“Moreover, he shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall inquire for him by the judgment of the Urim before the Lord. At his command they shall go out and at his command they shall come in, both he and the sons of Israel with him, even all the congregation.”

Principles with the Urim and Thummim

1. The head of the people could ask through the priest about matters of public issue.
2. The questions were about information unknowable without God speaking – What should happen? What would happen?
3. Questions framed for only one of two answers.
4. The verbs were “taking” and “casting”.
5. This is not chance, but God’s revelation.

“God’s Will”
