- I. The Basis of Paul's Prayer (1:18a)
 - enlightened to shine, to illuminate
- II. The Purpose of Paul's Prayer (1:18b-19a)
 - A. The Purposes' Character $(1:18b_{1-5})$
 - know intelligent comprehension, understanding
 - B. Purpose One: A Richer Understanding of Our Hope (1:18b₆₋₁₂)
- The General Call that gracious invitation to receive the benefits of salvation affected by Christ offered to all men, although not always effectual (Ac. 17:30)
- The Effectual Call that act of God whereby He through the use of the general call definitively draws and regenerates those whom He has predestined to adoption as sons (Eph. 1:4-5; Rom. 8:29-30).
 - Hope confidence or expectation regarding the future
 - C. Purpose Two: A Richer Understanding of Our Corporateness (1:18c)
 - riches bountiful, overflowing
 - D. Purpose Three: A Richer Understanding of Our Power (1:19a)
 - surpassing to exceed or overpass

 - A. The Means to Its Experience (1:19b)
 - working to operate, produce, or effect
 - strength overwhelming power, surpremacy
 - might capability, power
