Two topics of conversation that are kept from entering many people's homes and that are too often forbidden from being discussed around the dinner table. These are topics that are considered "taboo" and that should be avoided at all costs. Who decides what is an unacceptable topic of conversation and who gets to say what the church should or should not be involved in? Is it the secular mob who does not know God or is it the Creator and Savior of the world, our Lord Jesus Christ?

There is a time...

The Cross on Table Mountain

- January 1956 (Junior Chamber of Commerce Jaycee) completed the 60' tall cross
- Initially, the land was owned by the Idaho Department of Corrections (Gov. land)
- (14 years later 1972) Due to a lawsuit and loss of a concrete cross in Eugene Oregon, they
 had the wisdom and foresight to separate the land through an auction making the cross private
 property. \$100
- Mid 90's ACLU tried to attack the validity of the auction.
- Early 2000's Talk show host **Rob Sherman** a Chicago-based talk show host was speaking at Boise State.
 - Called for the cross to be torn down.
 - 10,000 people showed up to march in a protest against removing the cross and to express their support for it.
- There is a time to quietly buy land for \$100, there is a time to stand with 10,000 others and make an issue known.

It's not about being on the right side of history, it's about being on the right side of His story. Should the church stay quiet? Yes... when it's time.

Should the church speak up? Yes... when it's time.

"If you cannot speak in love you should not speak."

Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

Be loving and have a cup of coffee.

There is a time

- You should lovingly have a cup of coffee and have a conversation.
- I agree... in fact, I appreciate those rare opportunities to do just that.
- But there is a time...

 There is a time to sit down with a cup of coffee.

 There is a time to stand up and stop what is going on.

Children are being exploited and sexualized... harmed and lead astray.

Are we going to be a church that is involved in politics?

- I wrestled this for years
- We as a church and I as a pastor have no interest in chasing the government, wagging my finger, telling them what they are going wrong.
- However, I have no choice but to speak up when the government tries to silence the church, propagate aberrant lifestyles, or endanger our children.

Ps. 120:7 I am for peace; But when I speak, they are for war.

1954 Johnson Amendment (Senator Lyndon Baily Johnson)

Churches and other nonprofit organizations that are exempt from taxation "are absolutely prohibited from directly or indirectly participating in, or intervening in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for elective public office,"

Paul didn't lobby against Rome!

- That's because Rome wasn't America. You are in America (Right to peaceably protest)
- Gold Fringe Flag

John 15:20 "Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

they didn't persecute Jesus because He was quiet.

Lost Ground

For far too long we have thought that talking about the darkness was the same as doing something about it. Dear saints, please beware of our ability to critique something without seeking to change it.

Moses got Lot back

Genesis 14

4 Kings take over Sodom & Gomorrah and in the attack take Lot and his possession. Lot was loved by his uncle Abraham. Abraham called up 318 trained men and pursued those who took his nephew. In the night, divided and pushed back the enemy, recovered his nephew, all of Lot's possession as well as many other men and women.

David got his family back

1 Samuel 30

David and his men get to Ziklag only to find it burned to the ground and everyone's family taken captive. (Wept until they did not have the strength to weep any longer)

David found strength in the LORD his God. (vs. 6)

600 men to 400 men came to the (Boise River) Besor Ravine
