Nehemiah 11:1-2

One in Ten – expansion and density by draft

This chapter can read a little like going to a graduation ceremony, *names that can be forgotten as quickly as they are read* – but NOT TO GOD!

To God, these are individuals who committed their lives to the Lord, who labored for king and country, who gave of themselves for the work of their Heavenly Father. **When our name is called in heaven, it will mean something to God.**

Their central driving <u>force</u> was around worship at the temple and thankfulness to the God of Gracious restoration and powerful revival, who has watched over, helped, and blessed them back into the Holy City of Jerusalem.

Nehemiah 11:1a Now the leaders of the people dwelt at Jerusalem;...

Beware when a society wants to live and be where everyone does what is right in their own eyes – disorder, becomes difficulty, becomes contentious, and finally anarchy.

Judges 17-19 Son has mothers money, commits it to the Lord but makes idols, traveling Levite comes along and becomes a priest in Micah's house of carved images, then is taken to be the priest of a conquered city renamed Dan, then a traveling man staying in a guests house is subjected to a cultural evil much like Sodom and Gomorrah.

I just want the Spirit of God to lead... good! He usually leads through His leaders.

1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.

An old foundation became a temple, ruble became a wall, a deserted and broken city began to buzz, lively and vibrant again with community, opportunity, and worship of God almighty.

Like many accounts of powerful acts of God, He starts with what is common or plain. Even humanity – <u>it was not anything other than dirt!</u> If God made something so wonderful, living, capable, able to multiply within themselves, creative, with the capacity for emotion, creativity, sympathy, and the depth to understand sacrifice out of dirt. - 11 Leader of the house of God
- 14 Zabdiel was the overseer of the mighty men of valor
- 16. Shabbethai and Jozabad (of the heads of the levites) had the oversight of the business outside the house of God.
- 17 Bakbukiah, the second among his brethren
- 21 Ziha and Gishpa were over the Nethinim
- 22 Uzzi overseer of the Levites at Jerusalem
- 24 Pethahiah reported the progress and the state of Jerusalem to king Artax.

- Shammah Defended an entire farm field from the enemy and single-handedly fought back when all the other Israelites fled. (2 Sam 23)
