Mark 16:1-16

Mark 16:1-8 [Angelic Revelation]

Early - 3:00am-6:00am

Weight of Stone: 2,000-4,000 lbs. (was moved to let people in, not Jesus out)

Imagine going in, expecting to see the deceased body of Jesus, and instead, there is a young man, clothed in a long white robe, sitting on the right side.

ALARMED: To be thrown into terror or amazement – to gasp, hold your breath, flinch, shooketh. To be STRUCK with amazement.

To be thoroughly astounded or amazed – to be startled and confused...

He told you where to find Him

Mark 14:27-28 all of you will be made to stumble, strike the shepherd, BUT AFTER I HAVE BEEN RAISED, I WILL GO BEFORE YOU TO GALILEE. John 14 – I go to prepare a place for you...

AMAZED & AFRAID

Trembled: The jitters from too much caffeine, this is on an entirely different level.

Amazed: a throwing of the mind out of its normal state. Become unaware of everything other than a single object.

Bride on wedding day, a baby is born. FISH ON! Phones and social media.

To be hurled, thrust into a state of blended fear & wonderment (Luke 5 – paralytic)

Afraid: Matthew 28:12-14 When they had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, saying, Tell them, His disciples came at night and stole Him away while we slept." And if this comes to the governor's ears, we will appease him and make you secure.' So they took the money and did as they were instructed;

Mark 16:9-11 [Personal Confirmation]

Demons – *Matthew 12:43* (Consider the compilation of people)

Have you heard but not believed? Emotions have an interesting effect on thinking

Psalm 22:16-18 For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet; I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots.

Zechariah 12:10 They will look on Me, the One they have pierced... **Isaiah 53** (READ IT)

Mark 8:31 And He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

Matthew 26:31-33 Then Jesus said to them, "All of you will be made to stumble because of Me this night, for it is written: 'I will strike the Shepherd, And the sheep of the flock will be scattered.' "But after I have been raised, I will go before you to Galilee." Peter answered and said to Him, "Even if all are made to stumble because of You, I will never be made to stumble."



Took bread, blessed, and broke it. (Nail prints)

Matthew 14 – Looking up to heaven, blessed and broke the bread

Matthew 15 – 4k Gave thanks and broke it.

Matthew 26 – the upper room, The last supper, HIS Passover

Mark 16:12-16 [Choosing Affiliation]

I want to be on the team, but I want to wear my own Jersey – you can miss a pass, even fumble from time to time and we will keep you on the team, but you have to put the Jersey on.

I want to be married but not change my name, have other relationships, and not wear a ring.

Jesus had to deal with His disciples

Like varsity losing to the freshman team... get it together guys.

Hardness of heart: Unbelief: to withhold belief (Why hold back?!)

Proverbs 28:14 Happy is the man who is always reverent, but he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity.

Unbelief is not a matter of knowledge and intellect, it's a matter of the heart.

Condemned: tried and sentenced as guilty... worthy of punishment.

NO way God conforms His nature to your desires. YOU conform your desires to His nature.

WILL YOU BELIEVE?

Believe: To place confidence in, to trust that Jesus (ALONE) is able to Save.

That He is enough. As a bride, trusts her husband to provide, lead, guide, and guard.

Romans 10:9-11 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
