## Judges 4:4-10

4 Now Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lappidoth, was judging Israel at that time.<sup>5</sup> She used to sit under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in the hill country of Ephraim; and the sons of Israel came up to her for judgment.<sup>6</sup> Now she sent and summoned Barak the son of Abinoam from Kedesh-naphtali, and said to him, "Behold, the LORD, the God of Israel, has commanded, 'Go and march to Mount Tabor, and take with you ten thousand men from the

sons of Naphtali and from the sons of Zebulun.<sup>7</sup> 'I will draw out to you Sisera, the commander of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his many *troops* to the river Kishon, and I will give him into your hand.'<sup>8</sup> Then Barak said to her, "If you will go with me, then I will go; but if you will not go with me, I will not go."<sup>9</sup> She said, "I will surely go with you; nevertheless, the honor shall not be yours on the journey that you are about to take, for the LORD will sell Sisera into the

hands of a woman." Then Deborah arose and went with Barak to Kedesh.

10 ¶ Barak called Zebulun and Naphtali together to Kedesh, and ten thousand men went up with him; Deborah also went up with him.

# Don't Sit Under the Tree!

- Deborah was a Judge and Prophet (#4)
- God's Words need Committed Deeds!
  - Anyone can criticize “under the tree”
  - Cheerleaders are great, but where are you standing?
  - Deborah calls and inspires...
- She called Barak to Battle...



# Everybody Has a 'Body' ...

- We are all involved - our OWN place!
  - Deborah could not fight – could have done nothing
  - Barak - NO victory without Vision/HOPE!
- THERE IS A **PLACE** FOR ALL!
- BUT...are we all doing **our** part?
- The work of a woman/mother...



# The Goal of Encouragement

- “Behold, the Lord, the God of Israel, has commanded...”
- Barak gets caught in the “messenger” - the “message”!
- Exhort, counsel, admonish, edify, love...each other!
- God will draw out the enemy for destruction (7)
- What you fear, God will deliver into your hand!
- “I will surely go with you...” (9)



# On the Spirit's Side

- 1 Spirit-led, 1 reluctant, 10,000 followers! (10)
- Going to battle ???
- Ex. 33:15 “If your presence does not go with us, do not lead us up from here.”
- God’s presence is what we need!
- One another is what we were made for!
- ‘Deborah’s’ **ARISE!!!**
