A King after Their own Heart

- Sons for war, service, farmers, smiths
- Daughters for perfumers, cooks and bakers ¹³
- Taxes! Additional 10% on everything
- Best of servants and livestock ¹⁶
- Hope in man fails, promise of oppression ¹⁸
- Insistence on being like the nations ¹⁹



God Orders Saul's Steps (10)

- News foretold (2), meeting with sandwiches (3-4)
- Trip to the hill of God where the Philistines were (5)
- A promise of the Spirit of God and a change (6)
- Promise that the Lord would be with him (7)
- A command to wait for seven days (8)
- A heart that is changed—not improved! (9)
- Miracle after miracle—no faith built!



Saul Revealed (10)

- A Reputation for being among the prophets 11
- Samuel reminds the people of their rejection 18-19
 - Their indifference to God would be mirrored in Saul
 - He would be a man after their own heart
- Saul is selected by lot and then hides 21
- The people took him from the baggage 23
- The people are impressed by his appearance 24
