

# Neither will I...

•The AUTHORITY question... #1 of 6 •If you do not see JB, you can't see Me! •Fearing the crowds (32) •Jesus leaves them in their denial of Him •And teaches in parables...

The Vineyard •The 'wicked workers' – prophetic: Isa 5 •God's Side: -God is generous - everything needed -Hedge; Winepress; Tower; Workers -God is trusting - Responsibility, freedom -God is expecting - Looks to HARVEST -God is hopeful - He sends His own SON

# God's call

•Men have a choice to serve God/harvest —Personal and Global

•Israel had all that they needed to do this —What does this say to the church???

The Plot against the "Owner" —How much worse than this??
—Israel had certainly done this – long time!

# Message of the Beloved

•The Son comes – putting all at risk? •Trying to steal the inheritance? •God GIVES us the Kingdom -Joint heirs with Him Concerning cornerstones – rejected? -CHIEF, standard!

#### Leaders see it... fear - #2 of 6

•Pharisees & Herodians – -These are the Religious elite... -Flatter with what they should be and are not! -True, impartial, teacher of righteousness... -Ambitious, deceived, closed minded -Lawful to pay tribute to Caesar? -Herodians say "Yes!"; Pharisees say "NO!"

# Church vs. State

•Romans would charge Jesus with insurrection •Seems like a "no win" for Jesus... -"yes" denies the sovereignty of God -"no" would mark Jesus for death by Rome • "show me the coin which pays the tax" -Whose image? Whose inscription?



#### Jesus and the 'State'

•There is that which 'belongs' to "Caesar" -Rom 13 – honor, tax, custom, fear -BUT, those powers have limits! •Render to God what belongs to GOD! -Eternal citizenship --'in' but not 'of' this world, do not love it!

#### Now: the resurrection #3 of 6

•Sadducees are the next to try: (3rd grp) -Ridiculous and scoffing context (2Pt 3:3ff) -Denies God's blessings and power -Levirate Law - Dt 25:5,6 -Liberal and "enlightened" minds... POWER! -Pointed to the foolishness of afterlife -You err – scriptures and power of God (24)

### Authority

•Scripture plainly teaches of an afterlife -Job 19:25ff; Dan 12:2; Ps 49:15; Jn 5:25ff -You don't know God's power! Weak gods... -Afterlife exceeds all earthly relationships -Perfected, eternal, spiritual, rewarding -Things will be very different....

A scribes question #4 of 6 •Experts in the 'letter', details -Recognizes Jesus' answer to Sadducees •Greatest commandment? -Sabbath? Offerings? Rituals? Washings? -Love God first and supremely... -If you love Him, love His people

# Scribe responds -

•"Right, Teacher..." -He amplifies and applies -"answered intelligently" -Not far from the Kingdom! -Love brings us to His love... -They stop asking questions

One more thing... •Messiah David's Son? -Why Does David call Him Lord? Ps 110:1 •Thinking of Messiah as created is wrong -He is eternally existent, therefore GOD! -Jesus is making a plain claim to Deity -Common people hear this gladly
