Faith in The Workplace



INTRO:

This week was all about faith in the workplace. It can be an intimidating topic to live out and do well. Most of us have experienced awkward conversations or pushy faith in the workplace. Let's start the conversation by talking about how not to do this... Share with the group a time when you've seen it "done badly".

DIVE IN:

- 1. Read these passages together John 8:12, Matthew 5:14-16. Who's the light of the world?
- 2. What good is a light if it's hidden? What does it look like to be the light of the world?
- 3. What does Matthew say the outcome should be when we let Jesus shine in us?
- 4. Pastor Jeff referenced multiple passages that Jesus says "Take courage". What does it look like for us to be emboldened in the moments that often bring out fear and doubt?
- 5. Why do you work? What does your faith have to do with your answer?
- 6. Pastor Jeff shared some common challenges feel in living out our faith in the workplace. What's the biggest hurdles you feel in being the light of the world when you're at work?
- 7. How intentional are you in praying for your work and co-workers?
- 8. What does it look like for you to be "non-judgmentally available" in the workplace? How do you care for people without being condemning? Are you opening doors or building walls with your co-workers?
- 9. Read together Luke 16:10-12. How can you apply these verses to how you live faith in the workplace? What are you doing to be faithful in the small things in your workplace? Is God calling you to something BIG like he did with Mike?

NOW WHAT:

- 1. What part of this week's message has had the greatest impact on you? What truth(s) has God taught you through the message and our group discussion?
- 2. What do you need to do with that truth this week to become a fully engaged follower of Jesus?
