Characteristics of Adversity



1. Adversity is universal


La Adversidad es universal (Mat., 5:45)

2. It is impartial / Es Imparcial.


Because we live in a fallen world, trouble comes to all of us / Debido a que vivimos en un mundo caído, los problemas nos afectan a todos.

pasa y nos deja inesperadamente devastados.




5. Times of adversity may be prolonged

Sometimes the emotional or physical pain continues for years / A veces el dolor emocional o físico continúa durante años


6. It may be intense / Puede ser intenso



Galatians 6:7-9





For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. ³Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

- **Satan / Satanas.** He hates God's people (1 P., 5;8).
- **God / Dios.** The Lord is sovereign, and He controls all adversity in our lives. That's why it's important to remember how much He loves us. If He allows us to go through pain, suffering, or loss, then He has something good He wants to accomplish in us.




Responses to Adversity


1. Blame / Culpa.


4. Self-pity / Autolástima.

Dios con nuestra confusión y dolor.




Principles to help us through adversity

1. Adversity is one of God's most effective tools for strengthening our faith




**2. The Lord sends adversity to help us,

2 Corintios 12:7-10





For when I am weak, then I am strong.




**3. God is always with us / Dios siempre
