Matthew 24

Intro: Following Jesus means trusting Him enough to step beyond the walls of comfort, safety, and certainty, even when we cannot see what lies on the other side. Jesus promises that despite persecution, rejection, spiritual drift, and a hostile world, the Good News of the Kingdom will be proclaimed to all nations—and our calling is to faithfully endure, live as His witnesses, and trust the One who already knows where the road leads.

Story: Tell about a time when you sensed God asking you to take a step of faith, even though you couldn't see how it would turn out. What happened when you took the step?

Read: Matthew 24:1-14

1. Jesus calls us to endure to the end. What might endurance look like in ordinary Christian life?
2. What are some “3-foot walls” that can keep Christians from following Jesus more fully?
3. God gives direction rather than full disclosure. Why do you think we so often want to know the outcome before we obey?
4. Read Genesis 12:1-9. God didn't tell Abraham the place he was going beforehand, so what did Abraham have to know about God before deciding to go into the unknown?
5. What would it look like for The Well to be a church that is willing to “jump the wall”? What might that look like individually and as a small group?

- For courage to take the next step.
- For resilience in our love for Jesus.
- For boldness in the place God has us.
