### Ephesians 4.11 – 16 (NLT)

<sup>11</sup> So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup> to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up <sup>13</sup> until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

<sup>14</sup> Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. <sup>15</sup> Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. <sup>16</sup> From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

## Character trumps gifting

### 1 Timothy 3.2–7 (NLT)

<sup>2</sup> So a church leader must be a man whose life is above reproach. He must be faithful to his wife. He must exercise self-control, live wisely, and have a good reputation. He must enjoy having guests in his home, and he must be able to teach. <sup>3</sup> He must not be a heavy drinker or be violent. He must be gentle, not quarrelsome, and not love money. <sup>4</sup> He must manage his own family well, having children who respect and obey him. <sup>5</sup> For if a man cannot manage his own household, how can he take care of God's church?

<sup>6</sup> A church leader must not be a new believer, because he might become proud, and the devil would cause him to fall. <sup>7</sup> Also, people outside the church must speak well of him so that he will not be disgraced and fall into the devil's trap.







## Phase 1 I don't know what I don't know





Leaders who lack personal insight are like tone deaf musicians – they don't hear the noise that everyone else does

## Phase 2 *I know that I need to know*







Psalm 119.105 Your word is a lamp unto my *feet* – it doesn't say my *street*. It is often revelation one step at a time

## Phase 3 I know what I don't know





#### You get the answers to the questions you ask

## Phase 4 *I know and grow, and it starts to show*





## Phase 5 I simply go because of what I know
