

## **Without Vision[Who Has The Lead?] Discussion Guide**

### **Summary**

The sermon focuses on the importance of having God's vision and guidance in our lives, particularly through the Holy Spirit. Using examples from Habakkuk and personal experiences, Jonathan emphasizes that God reveals His vision step by step, giving us the direction we need when we need it. - What role does Scripture play in helping us understand God's vision for our lives?

This week, set aside 10 minutes each day for quiet time with God. During this time, read a short passage of Scripture and then sit in silence, asking the Holy Spirit to reveal His direction for your day. Keep a journal of what you sense God saying to you.
