The Flame That Forms Us [Bold Faith Believes] Discussion Guide

Summary

This sermon explores the theme of bold faith in the midst of doubt, using biblical examples to illustrate how faith and doubt often coexist in our spiritual journey. Jonathan discusses how even Jesus' disciples experienced doubt, and highlights stories like the woman with the bleeding condition and the father with the demon-possessed son to show that God responds to faith regardless of its strength. The message emphasizes that doubt is a normal part of faith development and that God is not afraid of or disgusted by our moments of doubt.

- What does it mean that God is our 'shade at our right hand', or 'the Lord stands beside you as your protective shade'? How does this image impact your view of God?
- Can you relate to the father's prayer 'I believe; help my unbelief'? Share about a time when you experienced both faith and doubt simultaneously.
- How does knowing that Jesus' disciples also struggled with doubt encourage you in your faith journey?
- What's the difference between knowing about Jesus and actually reaching out to touch Him in faith?
- How can we support each other in our community when we're experiencing seasons of doubt?
- What practical steps can we take to strengthen our faith while acknowledging our doubts?

Life Application

This week, identify one area where you're struggling with doubt in your faith journey. Instead of hiding from it, bring it to God in prayer daily, asking Him to help your unbelief while choosing to trust Him despite your uncertainty.
