

# **Without Vision [I Can See Clearly Now]**

## **Discussion Guide**

### **Summary**

This sermon focuses on walking by faith and trusting God's vision for our lives, even when we can't physically see or understand His plan. Jonathan emphasizes that true faith exists when we believe in God's character and promises, even without visible evidence. Using examples from Hebrews 11 and his own ministry experience, he illustrates how faith requires trusting God's unseen plan and surrendering control.

Heavenly Father, as we gather to discuss walking by faith, we ask that You open our hearts and minds to Your message. - Why do you think it's impossible to please God without faith according to Hebrews 11:6?
- What makes it difficult for you to trust God's plan when you can't see the whole picture?
- How can we maintain faith during seasons when God seems distant?
- What's the difference between walking by faith and being reckless or unwise?
- How has your understanding of faith grown or changed over time?

## **Life Application**

This week, identify one area in your life where you're struggling to trust God's plan. Each morning, consciously choose to surrender that situation to God and declare your trust in His guidance, even if you can't see how He's working.
