

## **Without Vision [Who's Got A Plan?] Discussion Guide**

### **Summary**

Today's sermon at Fusion Church focused on the importance of having a spiritual vision for our lives. Jonathan emphasized that without vision, people perish, as stated in Proverbs 29:18. The sermon explored the story of the Israelites in captivity and how God had a plan for them despite their circumstances.
