- How does knowing that everything comes from God and exists by His power impact your perspective on life?
- What are some areas in your life where you might be seeking your own glory instead of God's?
- How can we help each other stay focused on glorifying God in our daily lives?

### **Life Application**

This week, before making decisions or taking actions, pause and ask yourself, 'Will this bring glory to God?' Keep a journal of these moments and reflect on how this intentional focus changes your choices and perspective.
