The Flame That Forms Us [Bold Faith Stands Firm] Discussion Guide

Summary

This sermon explores the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego from Daniel 3, using their experience as a case study in standing firm in faith during trials. Jonathan emphasizes how these three men demonstrated 'even if' faith - believing God could save them but choosing to remain faithful even if He didn't. Their story illustrates how God walks with believers through their trials, breaking chains in the process.

- How can we maintain our faith when circumstances seem to be getting worse instead of better?
- What pieces of God's armor do you find most challenging to put on daily?
- How has God used difficult circumstances in your life to impact others?
- What practical steps can we take to develop unwavering faith like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego?

Life Application

This week, identify one challenging situation in your life and practice 'even if' faith by writing down both your hoped-for outcome and a statement of trust in God even if He chooses a different path. Then, commit to putting on the full armor of God each morning before facing your day.
