Summary

6. What role does faith play in trusting God's plan for our lives?
7. How can we support each other when facing 'impossible' situations?
8. What are some practical ways to stay calm and trust God in stressful situations?

Life Application

This week, identify an area in your life where you feel stuck or overwhelmed. Spend time in prayer, asking God to show you the way through it. Trust in His timing and be open to the path He reveals.
