As a called and ordained minister of the church of Christ, and by his authority alone, I therefore declare to you the entire forgiveness of all of your sins. You are forgiven in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit! Receive and welcome God's forgiveness, for you are made clean and whole again. In Jesus' name we pray.
