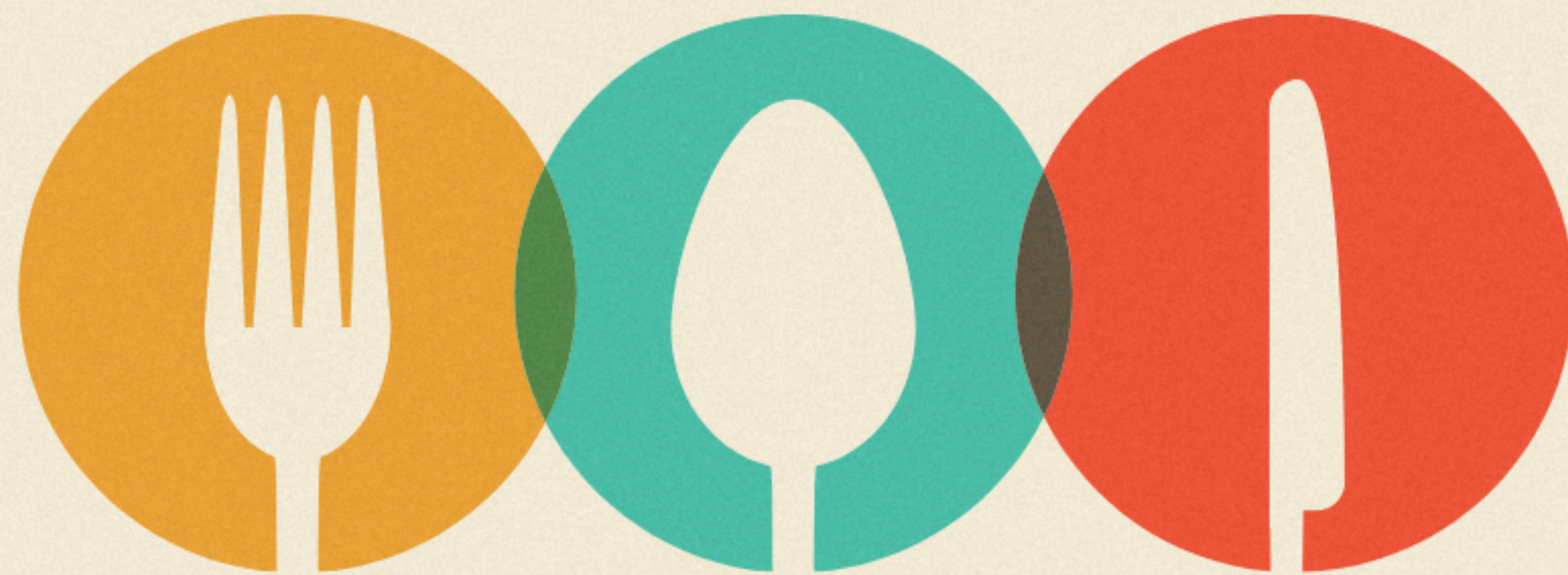
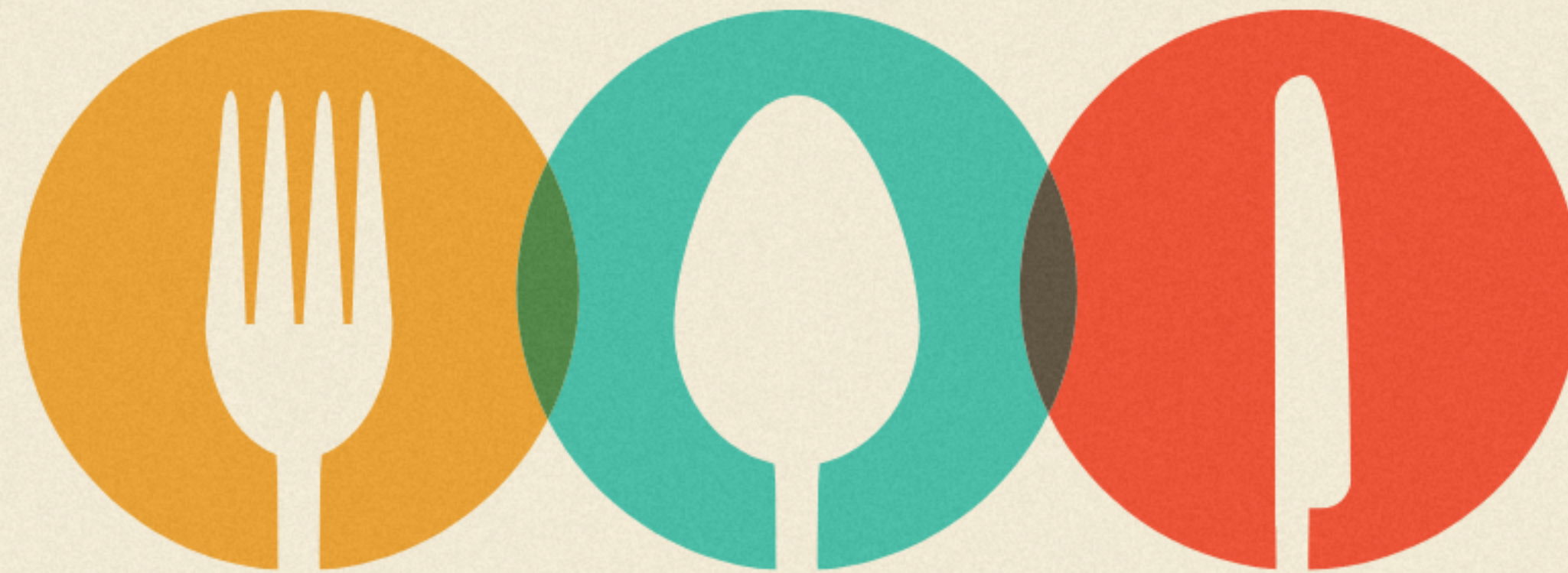



THE HOME OF SIMON THE LEPER




Now when Jesus was at Bethany in the house of

been sold for a large sum and given to the poor.”

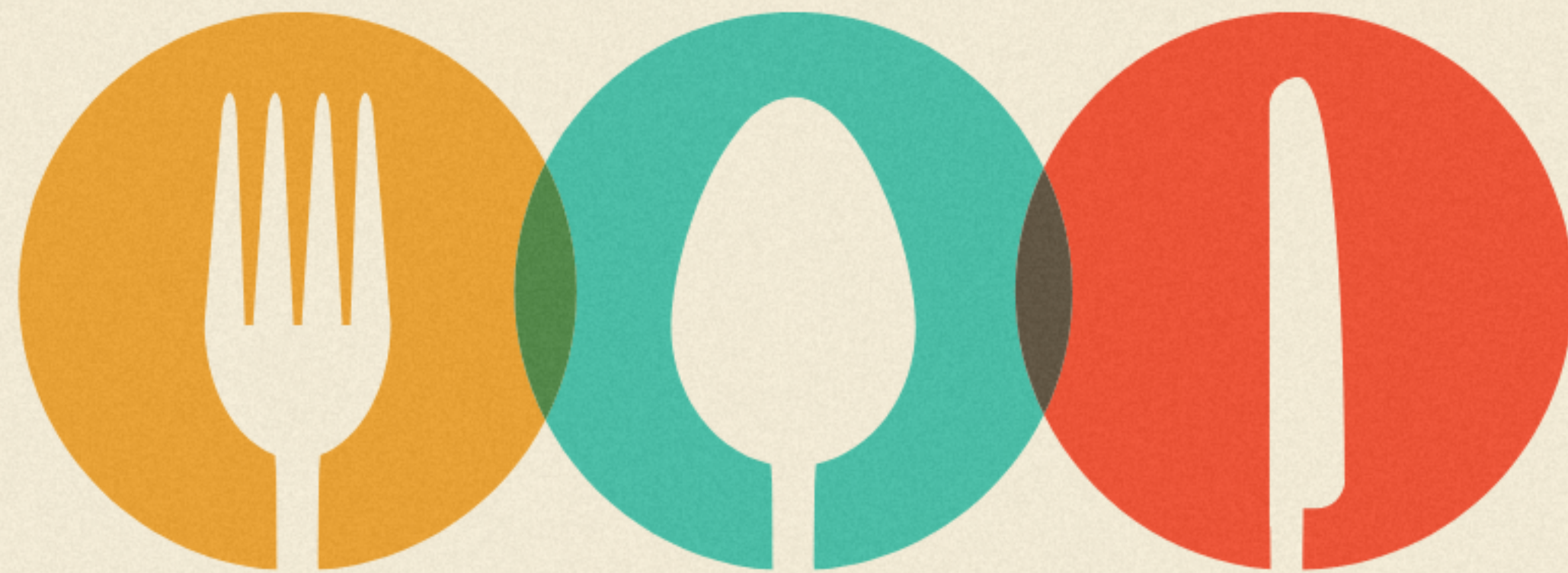
