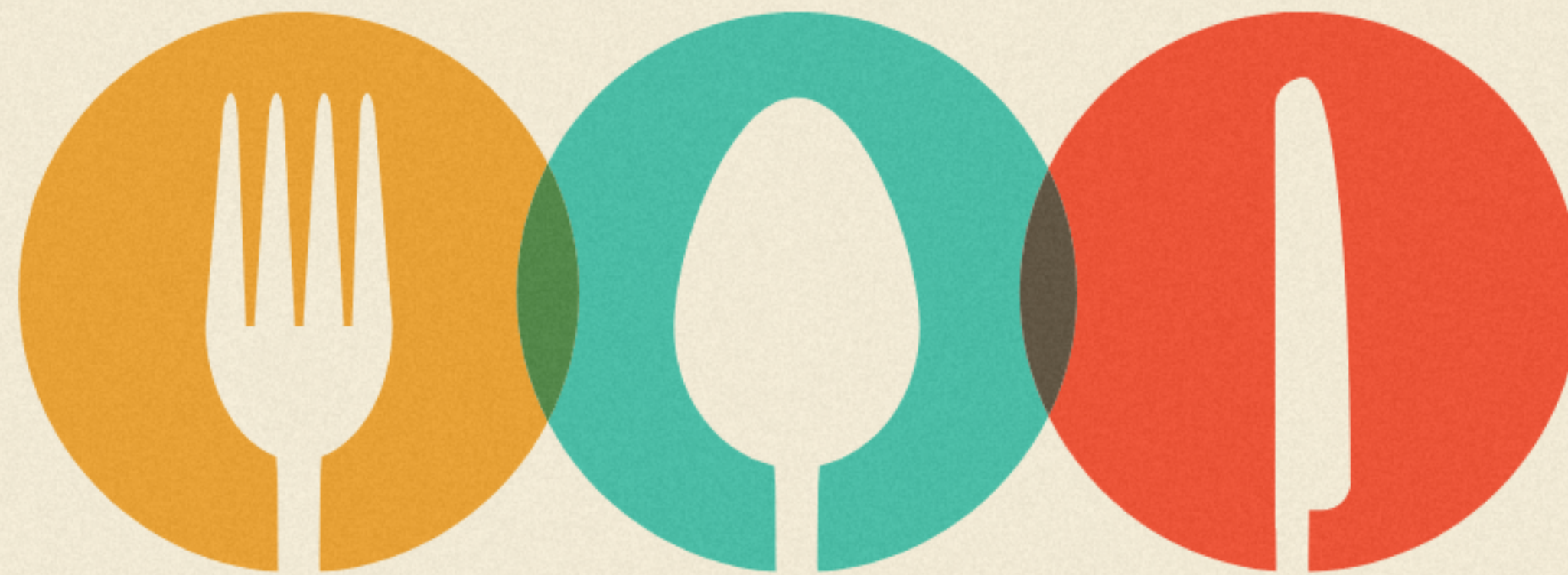

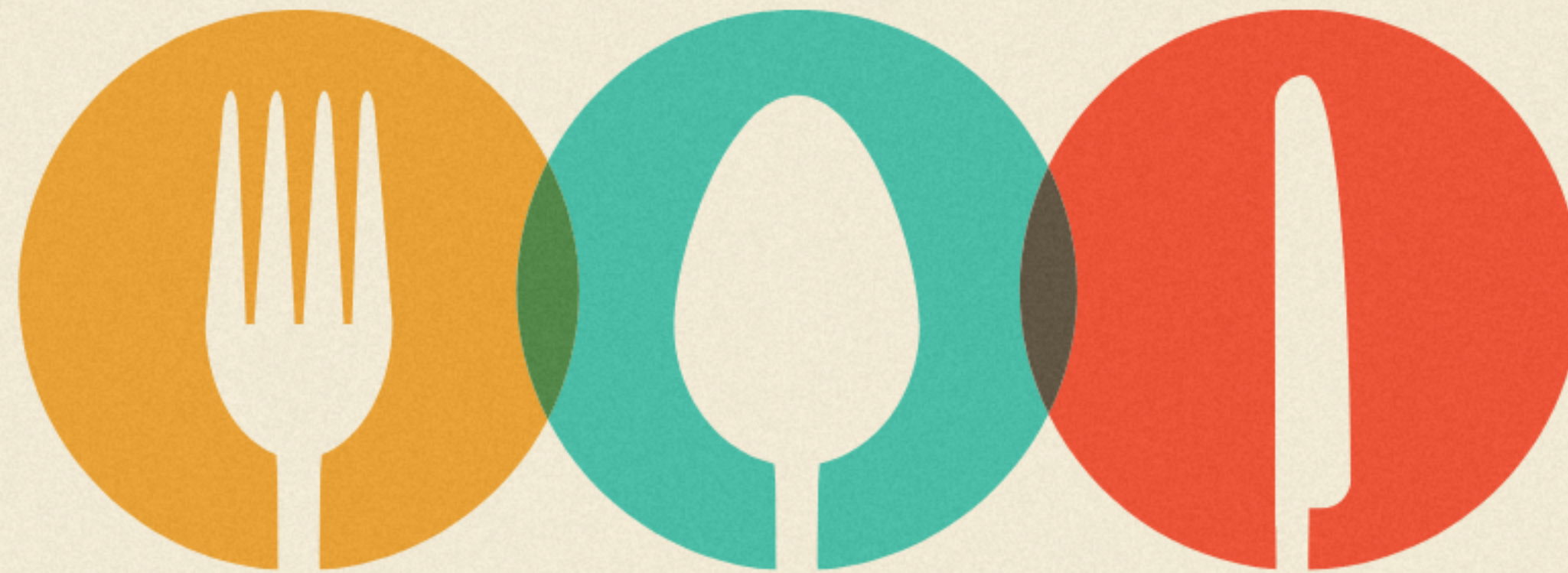




# THE EMMAUS AND JERUSALEM GATHERINGS



L u k e 2 4 : 2 8 - 4 9



— vv 28-29



— vv 29-31






They said to each other, “Did not our hearts








As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself






But they were startled and frightened

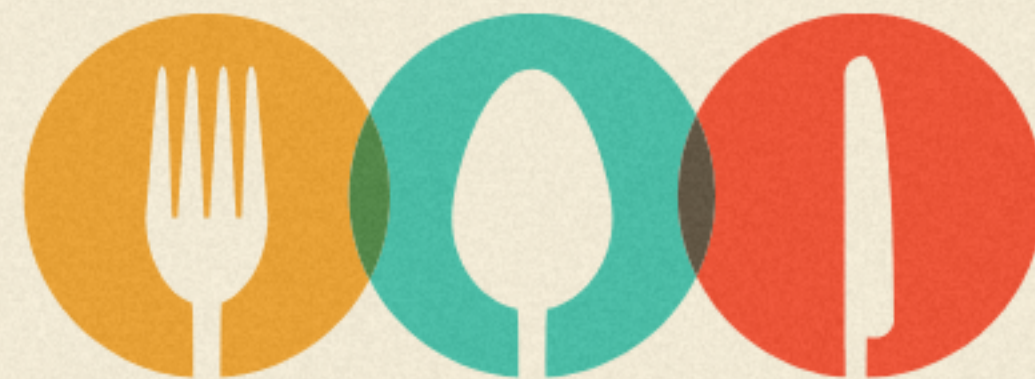

with the Father and was made manifest to us

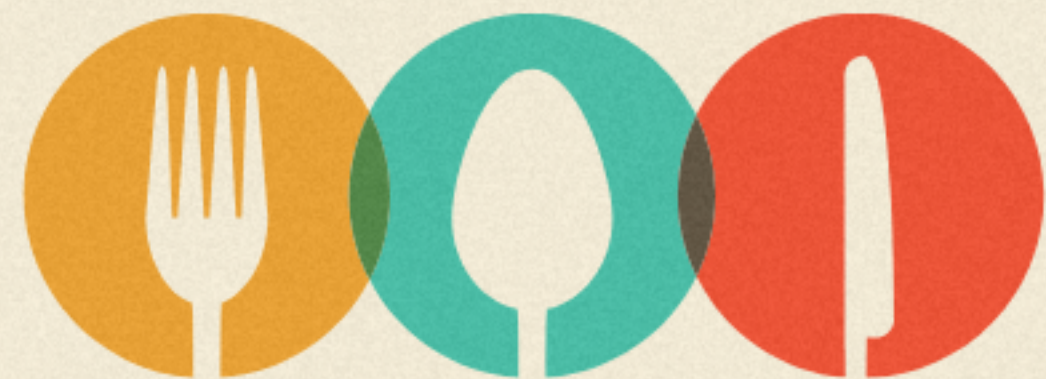




All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn

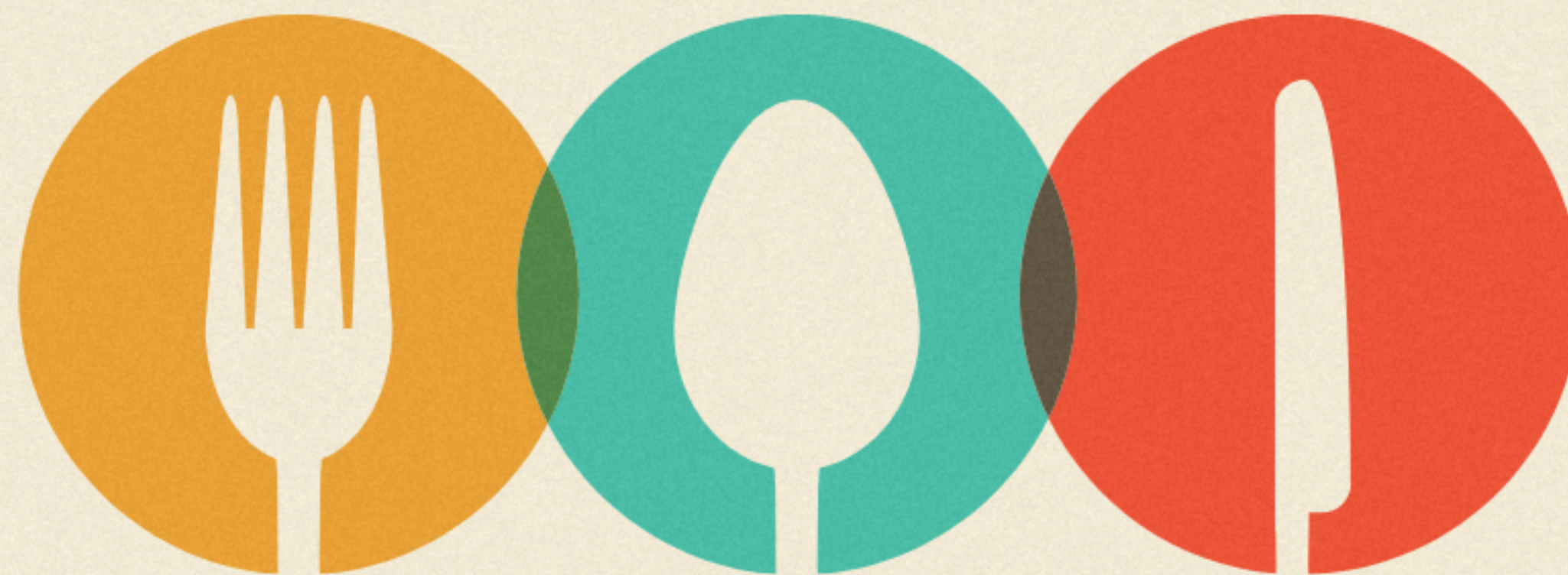
