
BREESPORT BAPTIST CHURCH

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 10-2-22

CONNECT:

- In our text this week David pretended to be something that he wasn't. When was the last time that you dressed up to pretend to be something that you weren't? What was the occasion and what did you pretend to be?

GROW:

- What part of this week's text or message stood out to you the most and why?

- David allowed his fear to push him toward idolatry. What kind of circumstances have tempted you in the past to seek rescue, relief, or identity in something or someone other than God?

- As a group, describe God in as many descriptive words as you can. How can things like fear, pain, discouragement, and opposition tempt you to forget and abandon all of that you know about Him and why?

- Sin is simple (1 John 2:15-17) and yet it makes everything it touches complex. How have you seen sin make things complicated in areas like marriage, friendships, parenting, submission to authority, money, sex, and work? How could you argue that God's way may not be easier but it is always simpler?

SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing that you can do this week to more firmly establish your heart in God? What is one practical thing you can do this week to help someone else do the same in a trial that they are facing? How can your Life Group help you in this?
