Job 3:1-10

CONNECT:

Nineveh was a massive city for its day. With that being said, do you prefer the country or the city and why? What is the biggest city you have ever lived in or visited and what did you enjoy about it?

GROW:

- What stood out to you from this week's message or text and why?
- God always begins to draw people to salvation from a starting point that is deeply flawed and steeped in deception. Is that statement true even for a child raised in a Christian home, why or why not? When you look at our prevailing culture, what are some of the most common flaws and deceptions? How would you address them?
- The history of Nineveh prior to Jonah's arrival points to the fact that God will often use circumstances to prepare people for the Gospel. What circumstances did God use in your life to prepare you to hear and respond to the Gospel when you were saved?
- How have Christians sought to instruct culture to recognize true beauty and what it means to be truly human in the past? How can we do so in the present?
