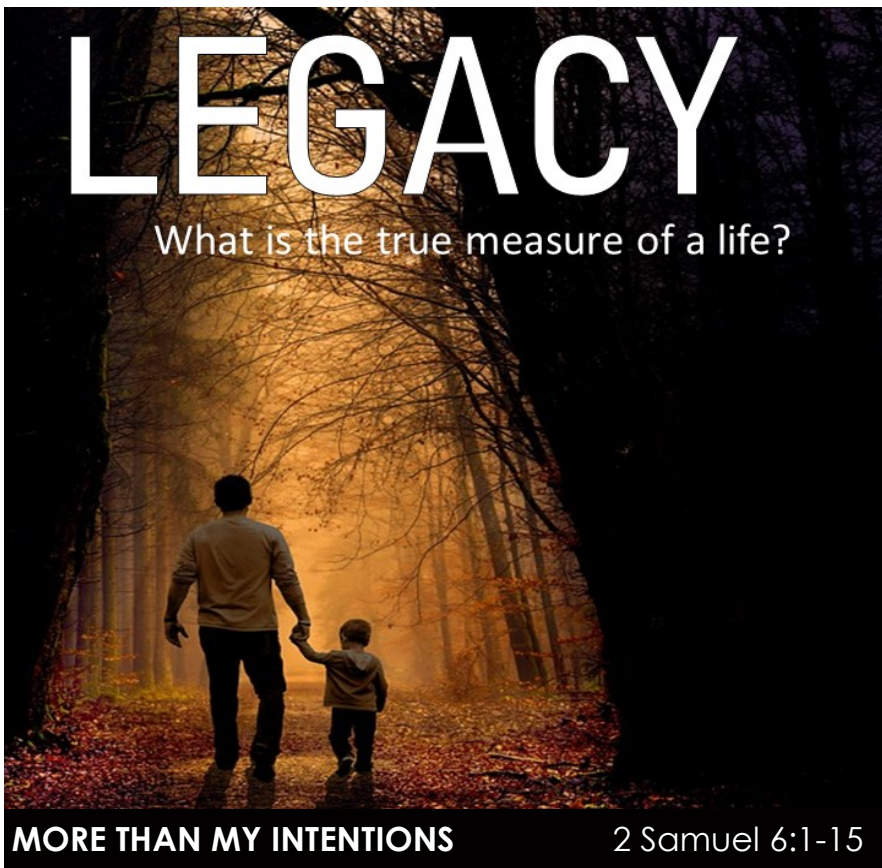

What is the true measure of a life?



MORE THAN MY INTENTIONS

2 Samuel 6:1-15

Have you ever had an experience where what you intended to do was not what you actually did? Most of us would say, yes, and the results are often called "accidents." The fact is, however, that most accidents aren't really accidents at all. They're the natural outcomes of poor choices that had unintended consequences.

This week we will see king David intend to do something good but it ended in tragedy because of a series of poor choices. Each of us needs to wrestle with the fact that, in the end, our Legacy will not be measured by what we intended to do, but by the choices we actually made.

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 10-9-22

CONNECT:

- Share a story with the group of a time in your life when you intended to do one thing but something very different ended up happening instead. What did you learn from that experience?

GROW:

- What part of this week's text or message stood out to you the most and why?

- How would you explain to a non-Christian that God's commands, limitations, and prohibitions are actually a good thing and evidence of His love for us?

- Why is it that so many of our good intentions never come to fruition? What can a person do to more consistently turn good intentions into good choices?

- How have you seen God bring something good from your poor choices or the poor choices of another? What does that say to you about our God?

SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

MULTIPLY:

What is one practical thing you can do this week in response to the fact that it isn't our intentions but our choices that determine the kind of life we live and the kind of legacy we leave behind? How can you help someone else who is struggling to make good choices? How can your Life Group help you in this?
