16 and older. Bring a friend! Please see the sign up sheet on the Bulletin Board to help us plan for a stress free, fun filled fellowshiping day.

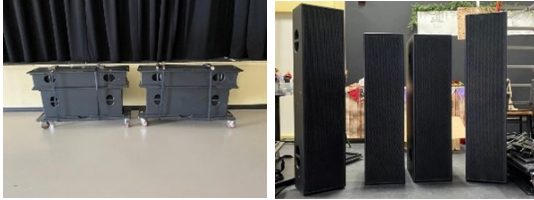
SILENT AUCTION FOR OLD AUDIO/VISUAL EQUIPMENT

The Trustees will collect bids from May 29th-June 12th. You can place your bid with your name on it in an offering box.

Only **members** can bid as stated in our constitution.

Three items are being bid on individually. All three items are on the gym stage if you want a closer look at them.

1) Portable speakers that used to be in the worship center. These speakers can put out a big sound and are designed for outdoor use. They are portable but heavy. We believe they are A-line acoustic emma2k-b line array speakers, however we cannot find a label on them anywhere



2) BenQ projectors (2) These are the projectors that used to hang in the worship center. Both bulbs still worked when we took them down, but we are not sure how many hours the bulbs had on them.



3) Assorted speakers.

These Speakers and wires have been around for a while. They sat on the stage pre-covid, and then were moved to the loft when we needed the gym and stage during covid. They haven't been used in over 5 years, and I don't know what their working condition is.
