Sermon Notes | 03.03.34 | International Celebration at Good News | Dr. Dele Davies

Immigrants have always been major contributors to the US. Famous ones include: Albert Einstein (Germany), Joseph Pulitzer (Hungary), Sergei Brin (Google, Russia), Chinua Achebe (Author, Nigeria), Elon Musk (South Africa), Nicola Tesla (Croatia), Andrew Carnegie (Scotland), John Lennon (England), Carlos Santana (Mexico). Also, those who at least one parent was an immigrant include Walt Disney (Irish-Canadian), Steve Jobs (Syrian), Barack Obama (Kenyan), Ray Croc (McDonalds, Czech), Nikki Haley (Indian), Colin Powell (Jamaican), Alex Rodriguez (Dominican Republic), Renee Zellweger (Swiss, Norwegian), Joan Rivers (Russian).

Good News Church is rich in its international congregation. It provides diverse resources to equip children of all ages. The Word of God is taught there, and we are encouraged to study it for ourselves. The leadership (Pastors and staff) are very grounded in Christ. The worship team is excellent. Life Groups are critical in helping to build community. The church is impacting society beyond its four walls.

So why do we celebrate International Day?

Dr. Davies thoughts: I strongly believe that God has not just brought us together to be happy that we have a diverse church, but perhaps He has brought us together for such a time as this to be the church that changes the world and unites our community and our nation. And in doing so, it changes the trajectory of our nation.

You don't see how? Don't worry, God does. It took Jesus and twelve rag-tag, uneducated people to change the world then. Imagine what we can do with what He has blessed us with here and now.

We have to start believing what we say. We must begin to declare what we know and believe. Your words have creative power.

- What does it mean "your words have creative power" and do you believe it? How have you seen it evidenced?

There has to be some discomfort when considering where God wants us to go. (1 Timothy 1:7) Can you share an example of this? Why is this statement true?

- 3. WE ARE UNITED THROUGH CHRIST Galatians 26-28
- 4. WE EMBRACE OUR DIFFERENCES 1 Corinthians 12:12-14
- 5. WE ARE A PLACE WHERE ALL BELIEVERS BELONG! 1 Corinthians 12:15-17

We have to actually believe it. We are called to be that unifying bridge for our world.

We must treat all parts of the body with dignity. The most vital parts are the unseen parts. Not only in the physical but in the spiritual realm.

- What is an unseen body part that often does not get respected for how vital it is?
- What is an unseen "body part" in the Kingdom that often gets unrecognized and under-valued?

In election times, people get the most divided. If we are going to stand out we must show unity. Who is going to change the situation? **Look in the mirror. It is up to us.**

- Will we keep cursing the darkness or will we light a candle? Explain this question and share your thoughts.

It is incredible the light produced when multiple candles are lit. (think how Christmas Eve service looks - lighting one candle at a time.)

- How can we do this? How can we stand out and represent unity even in our differences?
