### Goal: What we're after this week...and every week

The goal of our discussion each week is to help us believe and apply the truths of God's Word in a gospel-centered way. This week we are discussing how work is a blessing and designed to glorify God.

### Gospel Application (15-20 minutes)

- Where do you find value and meaning in your work? If not in God, then where?
- What is God doing in our work? Why is it important that we work with joy?
- How has Jesus shown us how to work? How should we follow his direction?
