Goal: What we're after this week...and every week

The goal of our discussion each week is to help us believe and apply the truths of God's Word in a gospel-centered way. This week we are discussing how God according to his sovereign nature allows things to happen in order to demonstrate His supremacy and glory.

Begin with Prayer (5-10 minutes)

We want to start with prayer. How are you coming into the gathering? Where is your heart in relation to Christ and your community? Let's pray that the Spirit of God would empower us to be fully present with each other and transparent before God's Word. Let's begin each gathering with 5-10 minutes of worshipful prayer.

Introduction Question (5-10 minutes)

- What does it mean that God is Sovereign?

Scripture Reading and Review (10-15 minutes)

- What does this opening 4-0 sweep say or reveal about God?
- Why would God harden Pharaoh's heart?

Gospel Application (15-20 minutes)

- What good things created by God have you turned into a god/idol instead of fuel for worship of the One True God? (Pharaoh's magicians mimicked God's power but with cheap perversions. How do you do the same in your life?)
- How should the reality of God's sovereignty lead us to repentance and faith?
- What comfort and hope should we as Christians have in the sovereign nature of God?
