Goal: What we're after this week...and every week

The goal of our discussion each week is to help us believe and apply the truths of God's Word in a gospel-centered way. This week we are discussing how God according to his sovereign nature allows things to happen in order to demonstrate His supremacy and glory.

Begin with Prayer (5-10 minutes)

We want to start with prayer. <u>How are you coming into the gathering?</u> Where is your heart in relation to <u>Christ and your community?</u> Let's pray that the Spirit of God would empower us to be fully present with each other and transparent before God's Word. Let's begin each gathering with 5-10 minutes of worshipful prayer.

Introduction Question (5-10 minutes)

What does it mean to worship something?

Scripture Reading and Review (10-15 minutes)

- Why does God "harden Pharaoh's heart" and why would He ordain 10 plagues instead of just one? What is the significance of these acts of God?
- How do the Plagues reflect the justice AND mercy of God?

Gospel Application (15-20 minutes)

- What idols or "functional Saviors" are you tempted to worship instead of the One True God? How have they let you down? (Pharaoh's magicians mimicked God's power but with cheap perversions. How do you do the same in your life?)
- How should the reality of God's supremacy lead us to repentance and faith?
- What comfort and hope should we as Christians have in the and supreme and sovereign nature of God?
