Goal: What we're after this week...and every week

The goal of our discussion each week is to help us believe and apply the truths of God's Word in a gospel-centered way. This week we will discuss how we, like Israel, are prone to walk by sight and not by faith.

Begin with Prayer (5-10 minutes)

We want to start with prayer. How are you coming into the gathering? Where is your heart in relation to Christ and your community? Let's pray that the Spirit of God would empower us to be fully present with each other and transparent before God's Word. Let's begin each gathering with 5-10 minutes of worshipful prayer.

Introduction Question (5-10 minutes)

- What does it mean to walk by faith?

Scripture Reading and Review (10-15 minutes)

- How did the attitudes of the people of Israel change from last week?
- How does God respond?

Gospel Application (15-20 minutes)

- Do you struggle with complaining? Do you readily cast doubt on people's motives/abilities when you disagree? Are you becoming obstinate? (Rom 15:4)
- Do you trust the Lord's words and His guidance even when you cannot see results? Do you remember where your very life comes from? Deut. 8:3b
- How will you trust the Lord with what concerns you today?
- Challenge each person in your group to make a deliberate and sustained effort to dig into scripture everyday for the purpose of learning more about our amazingly good, gracious, and selfexistent God.
