- ? How does an approach that encourages folks to "Add Jesus" or, "Try Jesus" fall short of a "Jesus is my life, Jesus is my identity" understanding?
- ? What could you do (or continue doing) to advance the Gospel? What does our church offer that you could us to serve, fellowship, grow, etc.?
- ? Acts 4:34 says "there was not a needy person among them" Why is that? See: Acts 2:44-45 and 4:32-35
- ? "Jesus loosened their grip on the things that seem to matter most in society." How does a Christian's focus and motivation differ from the worlds?
- ? To what degree does a person's budget demonstrate where their heart is?
- ? What does it look like to "Love Each Other & Do Life Together" as the church? Have you experienced this, have others experienced it from you?
