Goal: What we're after this week...and every week

The goal of our discussion each week is to help us believe and apply the truths of God's Word in a gospel-centered way. This week we are discussing how our failures and trials, can lead us to a clearer view of God's greatness and goodness.

Begin with Prayer (5-10 minutes)

We want to start with prayer. <u>How are you coming into the gathering?</u> Where is your heart in relation to <u>Christ and your community?</u> Let's pray that the Spirit of God would empower us to be fully present with each other and transparent before God's Word. Let's begin each gathering with 5-10 minutes of worshipful prayer.

Introduction Question (5-10 minutes)

- Have you gone through something, perhaps you still are, where it was hard to see God's faithfulness? Maybe, you felt God couldn't hear you or wasn't listening. (*Have each person in the group briefly share*)

Scripture Reading and Review (10-15 minutes)

- What does this text show us about God? What characteristics does God reveal about himself?
- In what ways is Jesus a better deliver than Moses?

Gospel Application (15-20 minutes)

- We tend to look at ourselves as our own deliverer. How does this manifest itself in your life? In contrast, what does it look like to trust in Jesus as your deliverer?
- How are these different: 1.) Evaluating God through the lens of my experiences; 2.) Evaluating God through the lens of His Word? How might these approaches play out in your life?
- What things do you need to repent of and believe about God?
