- ? What was Paul's charge to the Philippian believers (v. 27)?

- ? What does it mean to Stand Firm? (Entrenched! "We must know what we believe and have the capacity to stand there!" -D.R.
 - Related Questions: Do we know what we believe? Can we articulate the gospel?
- ? What descriptive phrases does Paul use to refer to a unified body of believers?
 - Dustin emphasized that "Striving side by side for the Faith of the Gospel" means we are moving forward together, gaining ground together: Practically speaking, how can we foster that kind of progress?
- ? In the illustration of the tug-of-war rope, what point was made when one side dropped the rope?
 - Have you seen infighting distract Christians from their greater call? How can that be avoided?
- ? List the various words and phrases that reveal Paul's motives and attitudes.
 - Regarding the call to be fearless (v28) why should/can Christians avoid a spirit of fear?
- ? Discuss these challenging words from the message: "Are you at the rope? Are you in the game? Are we striving together?"
