#### **Chapter 7 Discussion Questions:**

#### 1. Be committed.

- ? What are some synonyms for commitment? Devotion, faithfulness, dependability, loyalty, stability God desires faithfulness from us, but keep in mind, HIS faithfulness is a constant theme in the Bible and WE are called to the same faithfulness! Hebrews 10:23
- ? What do you need to do differently to prepare yourself to live as a Stephen, regardless of the cost?

#### 2. Be a Bold Witness.

- ? How are you doing regarding having the conviction and courage to SPEAK the Gospel out loud?
- ? If you had to preach an impromptu (on the spot) Gospel Message what would you say? Have a volunteer from the group give it a try (let the group help them out!).
