# A GODLY MARRIAGE

I. Basis of a godly Marriage

Ephesians 5:31

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh."

- A. Marriage is God's Work
  - 1) Marriage was God's Design
    - It was God's design in creation. Gen. 1:27-28
    - God declared man's solitude was not good. Gen. 2:18
    - God made woman from man. Gen. 2:21-22

- A. Marriage is God's Work
  - 2) God gave away the first bride
    - God brought woman to man. Gen. 2:22

  - 3) God spoke the design of marriage into existence
    - Have you not read that <u>He</u> who created them from the beginning and made them male and female, and <u>said</u>... Matt. 9:4-6

#### 1. Basis of a Godly Marriage

- A. Marriage is God's Work
  - 4) God performs the "one flesh" union
    - It is God who ordains and performs the uniting
    - . . . the two shall become one flesh. So they are no longer two but one flesh. What <u>God</u> has joined together, let not man separate.

Matt. 19:5-6

  - 1) Leaving Past Relationships
    - a) Mother and Father
    - b) Family and Friends
    - c) Practical considerations for "Leaving"

Gen. 2:24

Therefore, a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife.

1) Leave Home Physically

- 2) Leave Home Relationally
  - New priorities
    - Spouse is new #1
      (Not Mom and/or Dad)

- 3) Leave Home Emotionally
  - First person to express feelings to is your spouse
    - Parents do not "trump" spouse

4) Leave Home Financially

- 5) Leave Home Spiritually
  - Being raised in a Christian Home does not make you a Christian
  - Only personal faith in Jesus saves you

- B. Man's responsibilities in a Marriage
  - 2) Cleaving to your Spouse "Hold fast"
    - a) Deep Attachment A strong, enduring bond
    - b) A covenant of unwavering devotion with loyalty to your spouse taking precedence over all other relationships.

- B. Man's responsibilities in a Marriage
  - 3) Weaving (become one flesh)
    - a) Intentional effort of building a shared intertwined life together
    - b) Examples of Oneness

# Spiritual Oneness

A shared faith and purpose, aligning their lives with God's will and supporting each other's spiritual growth

  - 2) Existing truth not previously revealed

#### **BEING ONE WITH CHRIST**

- 1) Choose Christ to be first in your life
- 2) Know and Obey His Word
- 3) Commune with Him often through Prayer
- 4) Allow the Holy Spirit to Guide your actions to be more like Christ

#### **BEING ONE WITH CHRIST**

The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

John 17:22-23

#### A. Husbands love

However, each man among you [without exception] is to love his wife as his very own self [with behavior worthy of respect and esteem, always seeking the best for her with an attitude of lovingkindness]. Eph. 5:33(a) AMP

#### B. Wives respect

And the wife [must see to it] that she respects and delights in her husband [that she notices him and prefers him and treats him with loving concern, treasuring him, honoring him, and holding him dear]. Eph. 5:33(b) AMP

- C. Practical Ways to Show Love and Respect
  - 1. Give preference to one another (Romans 12:10)
  - 2. **Build** up one another (Romans 14:19)
  - **3. Accept** one another (Romans 15:7)
  - **4. Care** for one another (1 Cor. 12:25)
  - **5. Serve** one another (Galatians 5:13)

- C. Practical Ways to Show Love and Respect
  - 6. Bear one another's burden (Galatians 6:2)
  - 7. Be kind, tender-hearted and forgiving with others (Eph. 4:32)
  - 8. Regard others as more important (Phil. 2:3)
  - 9. Bear with and forgive complaints against others (Col. 3:13)
  - 10. Encourage and esteem one another (1 Thes. 5:11-14)

#### **APPLICATION**

#### Be intentional about your Marriage

- Put other relationships in their place and make your spouse your #1 priority – <u>Leaving</u>
- 2) Make a covenant with your spouse that you will be together for life **Cleaving**
- 3) Work each day to build a shared intertwined life together **Weaving**

## **APPLICATION**

Be intentional about your relationship with Christ

- Truly repent from your past sin and selfcenteredness, and turn to trust in Christ alone
- 2) Purposefully **commit** to stay close to Christ, **prioritize**Him above all else
- **Grow** in the Grace and Knowledge of Jesus Christ, to become more like Him each day
