1. What challenged you from the message?
2. What questions arose because of the message or something that was said in the message?

2. Created vs. Formed

The message teaches that what is created serves a season, but what is formed endures and is passed to the next generation. How do you see God moving you from being merely “created” to being “formed”?

3. Jacob or Israel?

God said, “Your name shall no longer be Jacob, but Israel.”

Where do you still respond like Jacob?

Where is God calling you to stand as Israel—the formed, mature identity?

4. “The Son is alive & He governs my whole land.”

Jacob mourned until he heard Joseph was alive. The message says a dead Son may make you a new creation, but only the living Son governs your heart.

How does believing the Son is alive—and ruling—change how you handle emotions, decisions, or pressure?

5. The Turning Point: “It’s Enough.”

Where are you still waiting for something else before taking your

6. Hearing God as Israel, Not Jacob

God called "Jacob, Jacob," but spoke to Israel.
What does it mean that God speaks to the formed part of you?
How does that shape the way you listen and respond?

7. Letting the Living Son Touch Your Eyes

Jacob's vision changed when Joseph touched his eyes.
Where do you need the Living Son to touch your perspective,
identity, or expectations?

8. Formation That Outlives You

Israel lived on through generations.
What part of Christ being formed in you do you want to intentionally
pass to the next generation—your family, your church, or your
community?
